Notes for Applicants

- 1. In accordance with the Wireless Telegraphy Act, 1926, the appropriate licence must be held to cover possession or use of radio equipment. Possession or use of radio equipment without a licence is an offence which renders the offender liable to prosecution and, on conviction, fines and confiscation of equipment.
- 2. This application form sets out the standard information that is required for a single Fixed Wireless Access Local Area (FWALA) licence. In certain cases, the Commission for Communications Regulation may seek further information or clarification from the applicant.
- 3. A FWALA licence allows the Licensee to offer telecommunications services by means of a local area fixed wireless access network in the defined FWALA service area. A separate FWALA application is required for each FWALA service area.
- 4. Applications for a FWALA licence must be submitted along with the appropriate fee to:

The Commission for Communications Regulation Licensing Section (Ref: **FWALA** Licensing Scheme), Abbey Court, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1.

- 5. To submit a valid application (new application or amendment) it is necessary:
 - To complete all sections of the form in line with the Revised Guidelines to Applicants for FWALA Licences, ComReg Document 06/17R7.
 - To submit the full licence fee with your application.

Application forms not adequately completed cannot be considered as valid applications and will be returned to the applicant.

- 6. If there is insufficient space available on the application form, please attach any additional information on a separate sheet(s), indicating the appropriate section and question.
- 7. Every effort will be made to process applications quickly so that operations can start at the earliest possible date. To facilitate speed of processing, please ensure that your application is legible i.e. typed or completed in block capitals.
- 8. While ComReg makes every effort to accommodate each applicant's requirements, it should be appreciated that this may not be possible in all cases.
- 9. The annual licence fee for all new FWALA applications is €2800.

10. Where an existing licensee is licensed for part of a FWALA channel, it may be possible to submit an amendment to ComReg for additional channel bandwidth. The fee for this amendment is based upon the following table.
