Survey Background

Introduction

As part of our commitment to quality holiday provision, The Fund periodically surveys both our young guests and their parents to ensure we continue to meet their expectations and needs. This was last completed in 2006 as part of the comprehensive research project led by the DIT research team (Quinn, Griffin and Stacey) from the Tourism Research Centre.

"I can tell you there is not only two (good) things about Sunshine, there is a million; my kids wouldn't go with anybody for more than one night at home, but at Sunshine they would go a week without not even thinking of me."

Cohort

All children who remained within our age range for holidays in 2011 and who travelled on weeks 1, 5, 9 or 12 were invited to participate, along with their parents or guardians.


An explanatory cover letter stressed that all responses were anonymous and therefore criticism could not affect their selection for future holidays. To help maximise response, the questionnaires were kept short, written in simple language (lest literacy be a problem) and included a prepaid return envelope.


199 families were invited to participate, covering 218 children who attended Sunshine holidays in 2010. 51 questionnaires were returned; the response rate was 23.4%

Demographics of families who responded

59% attended Sunshine for the first time in 2010 59% of those responding were girls 56% were aged nine or ten Schools were the commonest source of information on Sunshine





Parents' Views

Satisfaction with Sunshine

Encouragingly, all parents surveyed were either happy or very happy with Sunshine holidays: 86% were very happy with the remaining 14% happy. No one was unhappy, very unhappy or unsure of their response.

"As far as I remember myself from my experience as a child in Sunshine House, change nothing please! Keep everything exactly as it is "

Willingness to recommend Sunshine

Our reputation in local communities has always been very strong, due largely to word of mouth from satisfied parents. This is particularly important in new areas or communities where we are trying to build our presence. From this small sample, 100% of parents would recommend Sunshine to other parents; many are already doing so, acting as local ambassadors for us.

Importantly, we didn't give a list of potential options to select from, so these are unbiased views of the benefits of a Sunshine holiday from a parent's perspective.

"It was a free holiday that gave me and my partner time together which we don't get; it was a chance for my child to take responsibility for herself without us there and to mix with other children."

What needs improvement

51% of respondents were unable to identify any area for improvement. Of those that did make a comment, there was a diverse range of suggestions as shown below. Of note, only one parent mentioned bullying as a concern.

Satisfaction with Sunshine

100% of the children surveyed enjoyed their holiday, despite some of the concerns they raised below, and that fact that one or two indicated they would not return in 2011.

Will you return?

96% of children expressed a wish to return for the 2011 holiday season. One child was undecided, and one indicated he did not wish to return.

What are the best things about Sunshine?

Our facilities were the most popular element of Sunshine holidays, closely followed by the beach. This supports our decision to invest considerably in playground equipment over the years.

What are the worst things about Sunshine?

43% of children were unable to identify any problems with Sunshine. Of those that did, the most dominant theme was of bullying and a perceived lack of response to it. The issues identified by more than one child are outlined in the table below.

A diverse range of other problems were reported by individuals, all of which are more trivial:

- "Water with jellyfish"
- · "Waking up early"
- "The cold milk in the morning and mashed potato for dinner"
- "I would like more pasta or change of food, that's all"
- "The beds are hard"

"The two worst bits about Sunshine is when Tom takes our points away and when it's raining" "I only wish there was summer camp available that operates like Sunshine House on a 2, 3 week basis for children, and yes, I tell everyone about how my child had such a great time. Thanks!"

"Your children are in the best capable hands and you would be depriving the child of not only a holiday but a life changing experience."

"I wouldn't change a thing. I am very pleased my son was so happy after his holiday, thank you."

"According to my son it's 'the best thing since sliced bread'!!"
