Directions for J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College students in the following degree programs, who intend to take advantage of the Guaranteed Admission Agreement with James Madison University Associate of Arts; Associate of Sciences

- When you have finished 45 or more credits in the approved transferable degree program, it is your
 responsibility to obtain a *Student Letter of Intent form* and *Request for Official JSRCC Transcript form*from a career counselor or transfer specialist in the Career, Employment and Transfer Center at either
 Downtown Campus or Parham Road Campus or from the Access Center Coordinator at the Western Campus.
 The Student Letter of Intent form, when completed, formally indicates that you wish to enroll at James
 Madison University after graduating from J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College. You will not be
 reminded to complete this step.
- 2. Make sure you keep one copy of the Student Letter of Intent, signed by a JSRCC transfer counselor or transfer specialist in the Career, Employment and Transfer Center or the Access Center Coordinator at the Western Campus. Please also keep a copy of the completed and signed Request for Official JSRCC Transcript form. J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College will mail the original copy of the Student Letter of Intent with your transcript to James Madison University by the appropriate application deadline.
- 3. Apply online to James Madison University.
- 4. The deadline for JMU receiving your completed application and all transcripts including your high school transcript is January 15 for summer. The deadline for fall transfer student admission is typically March 1. The deadline for spring transfer student admission is typically October 15. (Spring admission is limited and restricted to students who have completed an associate degree.) More specific information can be obtained directly from JMU. If applying for financial aid, look at JMU's website for details about deadlines.
- 5. Please note the following eligibility information about the Guaranteed Admission Agreement:

In order for the agreement to apply, you must meet each of the following requirements:

- You must be enrolled in a J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree.
- You must fill out a Student Letter of Intent Form after completing 45 credits at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College and before applying for admission to James Madison University.
- At least 38 credits, or 60% of your transferable degree, must have been completed at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College. No more than 25 credits may be taken elsewhere. If that is not the case, you need to have a minimum 3.0 on all college work taken over the past five years.
- After filling out the Letter of Intent, you must complete all requirements for graduation at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College, and you must graduate with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0. Cumulative grade point average includes all courses taken at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College that count toward the approved transferable degree and all other courses taken at J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College.
- At the end of the semester, request J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College's Office of Admissions and Records to send your final transcript to James Madison University.
- Students graduating in summer rather than in May will be considered on a case-by-case, space available basis. (Preference is given to students who graduate in May, and to those students who, if graduating in summer, have not postponed math, science, or other core requirements.)
- This agreement is valid within five years of your graduation from J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College. After that, a student is still eligible to apply to JMU, but through the traditional admission process rather than through the GAA.
