

1. GENERAL INFORMATIONS - As seen in Newsletter N°1

1.1. Participation and composition of the teams

This competition is aimed at youngsters (girls and boys) born in 1992, 1991, 1990 and 1989.

There will be 4 competitions per team:

- School team championship for Boys,
- School team championship for Girls,
- Team championship of selection for Boys,
- Team championship of selection for Girls.

1.2. Conditions of participation

- 1.2.1. Each country can present:
 - <u>one school team</u>: all the players must have attended the same school since the beginning of the school year.
 - a selection team: all the players must have attended school since the beginning of the school year.
- 1.2.2. Selection teams can only be registered by countries which have registered school teams.
- 1.2.3. The number of participating teams is limited to 56: 28 teams of girls and 28 teams of boys.
- 1.2.4. All the players of the champion boys school team must belong to the same school. All the players of the champion girls school team must belong to the same school. The players of the selection teams can belong to different schools.
- 1.2.5. A player may only play in one championship.
- 1.2.6. Each country can only register one team per championship.
- 1.2.7. Each participating team must be officially appointed either by the school sport federation or by the organization in charge of school sport or by the Ministry of Education of the country.

1.3. Composition of the Delegation

The delegation for the school team competition is made of ten (10) people at the most:

- One girls team: four (4) players and one adult in charge of the team.
- One boys team: four (4) players and one adult in charge of the team.

The delegation for the selection team competition is made of ten (10) people at the most:

- One girls team: four (4) players and one adult in charge of the team.
- One boys team: four (4) players and one adult in charge of the team.

One (1) head of delegation ensures the monitoring of all country teams.

One full delegation (school team + selection team) is made of 21 people at the most.

2. DRAW

- The draw for the teams events will take place in May 2006 at the meeting of the Organizing Committee in the presence of an ISF representative.
- The draw will take into account results of previous ISF Badminton Championships.
- If after the draw, one or more teams withdraw from the event, the ISF Badminton technical commission may adjust the draw to equalize the numbers of teams in each group. This will conform to IBF regulations.
- the Organizing Committee will publish the draw immediately after it is made and subsequently if changes prove necessary.

3. TOURNAMENT RULES

- All teams and players agree to play against teams and players from all other countries
 according to the program defined by the Organizing Committee and take part in all social
 and cultural events.
- All matches will be played under the rules of the game as laid down by the International Badminton Federation (IBF). Matches will be played as the best of 3 games, to 9 points with setting to 10 points at 8 all if required.
- All matches will be played in the "Palais des Sports" of Tours_: in the ice rink (10 soft courts) and in the "Salle Grenon" (4 soft courts).
- All matches will be umpired by young national umpires. All play will be controlled by national or international referees.
 - All matches will be played with feather shuttles which comply with IBF regulations and are sponsored by the company BABOLAT, official partner of the ISF.

4. SYSTEM OF PLAY

- The system of play will depend upon the size of the final entry into the championship.
- The same system of play will be used in each team event (school and selection).
- In the team event, teams will be placed in preliminary groups of at least 3 teams.
- The order of play will be: double n°1 (player n°1 + one other), double n°2 (the others 2 players), single n°1, single n°2, single n°3.

NB: All four players will play in the doubles matches.

A team arriving with only 3 players will be removed.

In case of an injury, they will concede second double match.

- The draw of the Friendship mixed doubles will be made by the Organisation Committee.
- Players will play with partners from a different country.

5. PRIZES AND CERTIFICATES

- Each player will receive a commemorative certificate.
- Teams placed first, second and third in the team events will receive medals.
- The Fair Play trophy will be awarded to a team by the Discipline Commission after consultation with the ISF Technical Commission, the teams and the Organizing Committee.

6. REGISTRATION AND DEADLINES FOR ENROLMENT

- 6.1. The registration form must be filled in one of the official languages of ISF and sent back to the Organizing Committee.
- 6.2. The definite participation of the countries is to be confirmed with this newsletter N° 2. The registration form enclosed with the newsletters 1 and 2 must be sent to the Organizing Committee before the 15th December 2005.
- 6.3. You must fill in the detailed form the names of all the players and officials before 31st March 2006. This form will be enclosed with the newsletter N° 3.

7.5. Meals

On the day of arrival: dinner or lunch (according to the arrival time)

Other days: breakfast - lunch - dinner.

Day of departure: breakfast.

All meals (breakfast - lunch - dinner) will take place at the swimming pool cafeteria in the "Palais des Sports".

7.6. Accommodation

All participants will be accommodated at hotels. Accommodation will be in 2, 3 or 4 bedded rooms, teams coaches will be accommodated in twin bedded rooms and heads of delegation in single rooms.





7.7. <u>Transportation and stay expenses</u>

- 7.7.1. Transportation from the native country to Tours or Saint-Pierre des Corps train station is organised and financed by each country taking part.
- 7.7.2. The stay expenses given by the ISF come to $38,00 \in \text{per day}$ and per person.
- 7.7.3. For each extra person from the delegation, the stay expenses will come to 98,00€ per day, except for the coach driver accompanying the teams for whom it will come to 38,00 € per day.
- 7.7.4. The participation fees per day and per participant from a non-member country or a country having paid late will cost 98,00 €.
- 7.7.5. A deposit representing two days of fees per member (76,00 \in) will have to reach the organizers before <u>15th December 2005</u>.
- 7.7.6. A financial contribution to the ISF of 15, 00 \in per member of the delegation will be requested when the teams register.
- 7.7.7. If the distance between Paris and the departure city is over 5000 kilometres, the delegation may arrive one day earlier at the regular price of the stay (38,00 €).

7.8 Certification

Each competitor will be required to prove they are officially registered in the school they represent by providing a written certificate by the head of school with the school stamp.

In the case of their participation to a select team, they will have to appear on the official list signed by and with the school federation stamp which will certify their belonging to a school.

Each participant will have to present their passport or ID card at the control commission which will validate their participation in the competition

7.9. Insurance

All participants must be insured by their country for the whole length of their stay in France

8. DEPOSIT

Each member of the ISF must pay a deposit to confirm their participation:

- 456 € for one team (4 players + 1 team leader + 1 head of delegation)
- 836 € pour 2 teams (8 players + 2 team leaders + 1 head of delegation)
- 1216 € pour 3 teams (12 players + 3 team leaders + 1 head of delegation)
- 1596 € pour 4 teams (16 players + 4 team leaders + 1 head of delegation)

This sum will be deducted from the total amount paid upon arrival in Tours.

This deposit is only refundable if the delegation absent at the competitions let the organisers know before the draw on May 2006.

The organizing committee must receive the deposit before 15th December 2005

9. REGISTRATION

- 9.1. The registration form enclosed with this newsletter will have to be fully completed and signed by the National organisation of school sport and then returned as soon as possible at the latest 15 th December 2005 to the organiser with the appropriate deposit.

10. PARTICIPATION

Each member of the delegation will receive an accreditation card delivered by the control commission on which there will be an ID photo validated by the signature of the President of the commission. The ID photos will be enclosed with the form in the newsletter $n^{\circ}3$.

11. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DELEGATIONS

- 11.1. Each delegation must be insured against material damages and personal liability: this certificate will be presented at the accreditation.
- 11.2. Each participant must present a passport to the control commission or a valid ID card with a photo.
- 11.3. Only the teams who will have attended all the opening ceremonies, the trophy awards, the closing ceremony as well as the cultural programme and the friendly mixed double match will be ranked.
- 11.4. The presence of each participant is compulsory during all the events.
- 11.5. Each participant must fully take part in the socio cultural programmes.

12. DRUGS

Anti-drugs control (usage of illegal substances) will be carried out during the competition according to the current law in France.

In that case, the competitor will be able to be accompanied by an adult.

If a competitor is on medication, they must provide justification and let the organizers know at their arrival.
