## **Beginning Danish for International Exchange Students**

For those who want to get just a little more out of their stay in Denmark, CBS is offering a voluntary beginning level course in Danish. This 5 day intensive course consists of 4 hours of instruction per day, August 15-19, 2005. Registration for this course is available on a first come, first serve basis.

Course objective: To enhance the period of study for exchange students at CBS with insight into Danish society by providing a working **basic** knowledge of Danish, including a general introduction to common vocabulary, grammar and syntax. Emphasis will be placed on precise pronunciation. Cultural aspects will also be included. Attendance and participation are vital to success in this course. The international office will arrange social activities for the evenings.

## PAYMENT

All payments must be made in **Danish crowns (DKK)** and must be payable through Danish banks. Any collection charges are the student's responsibility. This includes services charges for checks drawn on foreign banks. Students may use one of the following payment methods:

**Checks**: Cashier's checks, certified checks, traveler's checks, personal checks and money orders made payable to **The Language Center, CBS** will be accepted.

**Credit Cards:** Online credit card payment will be accepted. CBS accepts a wide variety of major international credit cards.

- The deadline for registration and payment is June 1, 2005. Confirmation of registration will be sent via e-mail.
  - Payments made after June 1, 2005, are subject to an additional DKK 50 late fee.

- On-site registration is on a first –come, first serve basis ONLY space permitting.
