REFUND POLICY:

OSC must have all registration forms and copies of individual photo Identification prior to April 27, 2012. Full payment of \$3,800/\$4,000.00 for the outdoor season is due with all completed registration forms, copies of photo id and team application form. A \$500 non-refundable deposit will be accepted to secure your teams spot. If all information is not submitted your team will not be eligible to play. For any team information submitted after April 27, 2012 there will be a 48 hour holding period before the team will be eligible to play. Refund Policy: Requests for refunds must be made in person at the Oakville Soccer Club. A \$35.00 administration fee will be applied to refund prior to start of season. NO refund for cancellation after the start of the season. There will be an additional charge of \$25.00 for any N.S.F. cheque.

2. The Ontario Soccer Association, the ir Districts, Leagues and Clubs, directors, officers, members, employees, coaches, volunteers, officials, participants, clubs, agents, sponsors, owners/operators of facilities, and representatives (the "Organization") are not responsible for any injury, damage or loss of any kind suffered by a Participant during, or as a result of, any program, activity or event, caused in any manner whatsoever including, but not limited to, the negligence of the Organization.

Description of Risks

- 3. In consideration of my participation as a Participant in such programs, activities and events, I here by acknowledge that I am aware of the risks and hazards associated with or related to soccer. The risks and hazards of soccer include, but are not limited to injuries from:
 - Executing strenuous and demanding physical techniques in soccer;
 - Dryland training including weights, running, and massage;
 - Grass, turf and other surfaces including bacterial infections and rashes;
 - Falls to the ground due to uneven or imegular temain or surfaces;
 - Collisions with walls and soccerequipment;
 - Failure to properly use any piece of equipment or from the mechanical failure of any piece of equipment;
 - Spinal cord injuries which may render me permanently paralyzed;
 - Extreme we ather conditions which may result in heatstroke, sunstroke or hypothermia;
 - Contact, colliding or being struck by other participants, spectators, equipment or vehicles;
 - Vigoro us physical exertion and strenuo us cardio vascular worko uts;
 - Exerting and stretching various muscle groups; and
 - Thavel to and from competitive events and associated non-competitive events which are an integral part of the organization's activities.

4. Furthermore, Iam aware:

- That injuries sustained in soccercan be severe;
- That I may come into close contact with other participants, including the possibility of accidental and unexpected contact;
- That I may experience anxiety while challenging myself during the activities;
- That my risk of injury is reduced if I follow all rules adopted during training; and
- That my risk of injury increases as I become fatigued.

Release of Liability

- 5. In consideration of the Organization allowing me to participate as a Participant, Iagree:
- a) To a ssume all risks a rising out of, a ssociated with or related to my partic ipation;
- b) To be solely responsible for any injury, loss or damage that I might sustain while participating; and
