The Sufi Order International evolved from the universal spiritual tradition of the Chisti Sufi lineage. Hazrat Inayat Khan, whose teacher gave him the task to "unite East with West in the harmony of your music," communicated the fundamental metaphysics and practices of the ancient Sufis to the people of the West. Sufism has been called "the religion of the heart." It can also be understood as a path for mental and spiritual transformation through the transcendent wisdom of Love, Harmony and Beauty, and the realization of unity in God.
