STAFF INFORMATION SHEET

The U.N.B. Music Camp is a comprehensive music camp providing participants with a combination of enriched musical training with top professional musicians and music educators along with a balanced social and recreational experience. Students will be attending on strings, winds, percussion, piano and as choir members either as day students or as residence students.

Most music activity will take place between 9:00AM and 4:30PM, with evenings devoted to recreation and concerts. Staff will be in two categories; Residence Monitors and Day Staff. Residence Monitors, in addition to assisting in day activities, will be responsible for residence students when they are out of music classes according to the rules set by the Directors. Room and board in residence will be provided for Residence Monitors. Day Staff will have similar duties without the residence responsibilities and therefore will not be provided with room and board. When staff are not busy during the camp they are encouraged to take part in the recreational possibilities, ask faculty for lessons/coaching, practice, sleep etc.

Campers are between 10 and 18 years of age. Residence campers are between the ages of 12 and 18. Some will have had extensive musical training; most will have a basic school background. During the 4-5 hours of music instruction, they are divided according to age and ability. The music staff helps the faculty in the training of these students as individuals and in groups (band and chamber ensembles) on the repertoire being learned.

Staff should be 19 years of age or older with at least one year of University completed as of May 2013. Once a commitment is made to the camp it is expected that it will be honoured. This commitment will be made when the applicant signs the application form.
