Scholarship Guidelines

I. Scholarship Program

The Distribution Contractors Association (DCA) will provide selected scholarship recipients with tuition funds for the 2010-11 academic year. A total of \$15,000 annually will be awarded to eligible dependents of Association Members or their employees. Students from all academic levels – including incoming freshmen, undergraduates and graduate students – who represent a variety of majors and career goals are encouraged to apply.

Applicants will be judged on academic, citizenship achievements, short essays and financial need. Final selections will be made by a scholarship committee that will determine the amount awarded to each recipient. Applicants will be notified by mail of the final selection and the amount of their award.

The winning applicants will be awarded an unspecified amount of financial aid for the 2010-11 school year and this amount can be renewable for up to four (4) years with proof of academic success.

Award checks will be sent directly to the college financial aid offices of recipients. The scholarship is intended for use as payment of tuition and/or academic fees. Any balance may be credited to a second term tuition and/or academic fees or for expenses associated with the academic year.

II. Eligibility

Each applicant *must* be either the dependent of an employee, or an employee of, a DCA-member company, and should be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college, university or trade school for the 2010 - 11 academic year. In order to be considered for the upcoming academic year, applicants must submit their paperwork to the DCA Office by the *January 20, 2010* deadline. Selected criteria for DCA scholarships include scholastic standing, ACT and/or SAT scores, activities, community service, financial need and short essays.

III. How to Apply

- Applications will be sent to the DCA Member Company Representative, and can also be obtained from the DCA office by calling (972) 680-0261, or printed from the DCA website at www.dca-online.org.
- Applications that are received late or are incomplete will not be considered.
- Applications must include a high school transcript (for college-bound high school seniors).
- Application must also include an official or unofficial college transcript (for those who have completed one or more years of college).
- Complete the Personal Details page.
- Complete the Financial Need page.
- Remember, the student's application and supporting documents must be received by the DCA office no later than *January 20, 2010*.
