## **Documented Proof Of Residency Requirements:**

If you are a current resident in the Town of Millbury, the following must be provided:

- 1. A signed rental/lease agreement, a signed real estate sales contract, or a signed settlement statement/deed including the name and address of the parent/guardian; AND
- 2. A utility bill (gas/electric/water) for the current month, including the name and address of the parent/guardian

If you share a home with a relative that resides in the Town of Millbury, the following must be provided:

- 1. The relative's proof of legal residence; **AND**
- 2. Documentation verifying proof of the parent/guardian residing at the address, such as a driver's license, checking account, credit card statement, voter registration, paycheck etc.

A representative of the Millbury Public Schools may periodically visit the address given to verify residency. The actual address must be the location where the parent/guardian and student live.

An individual who owns property in the Town of Millbury, but does not reside in the district, is not considered a resident.
