**Conference Registration Scholarship: \$185.00**

**Travel & Lodging Scholarship:** The travel and lodging scholarship will be distributed by Benchmark at the conference. The amount is determined by the DHW region in which the scholarship recipient resides.

- 1) **Complete the 2007 Prevention Scholarship & Prevention Conference Registration Form (attached).**

- 2) **Attach a separate \$75 deposit check made out to Benchmark Research and Safety for each applicant.**  
Your deposit check will be returned to you at the prevention conference. If you do not receive a scholarship, your deposit check will be returned by mail.
