Barker Central School 2012 Summer Recreation Offerings

Any student entering **Kindergarten-12th grade** in the fall is eligible to participate in Summer Recreation, but you must be registered in order to do so. Activities for all areas will be age/skill specific. The HS gym is for students entering grades 6-12 while the elementary gym is for students entering Kindergarten-5th. The following is just a sample of the activities that will be available this summer at the Barker Central School Summer Recreation Program:

Arts & Crafts: Activities include tie dye, boondoggle, jewelry, gliders, etc. (Look for weekly updates posted in the Arts & Crafts Room or on the web site.)

In The Gym: Team games, individual games, tournaments.

In The Pool: Swimming lessons, free swim, competitive swimming, Olympic Day, Bring a Family Member to Swim Day.

In The Fitness Center: Supervised fitness activities with weights and fitness equipment.

Outside: Picnic games (Kan Jam, Bean Bag Toss, Lasso Golf, etc.), pick-up games, team games, nature trail walk, playground time, sports specific related activities based on interest level of attendees.

Off Campus Field Trips: Buffalo Bisons game vs. Toledo Mud Hens at 1:05 at Coca-Cola Field on Thursday, July 19 (cost is \$6.75 for a 1:05 PM game time with a departure time of 11:00 AM and a return time to be determined by the length of the game).

Martin's Fantasy Island on Tuesday, July 24 (Cost is \$13.95 with a departure time of 10:30 AM and return time of 6:00 PM).

NEW THIS YEAR is Lasertron on Thursday, August 2 (cost is \$18.00 for one attraction and arcade games or \$26.00 for two attractions and arcade games. Departure time is 11:00 AM and return time will be 5:00 PM). This trip will be for students entering grades 6-12 ONLY and there are strict height requirements that must be met. Attractions include Laser Tag and Go Karts. Students will be able to pick between the two attractions when we arrive. Students must be at least 42 inches tall for Laser Tag and at least 56" inches tall for Go Karts. PLEASE CHECK THIS PRIOR TO REGISTERING YOUR CHILD. If they do not meet the height requirements when we

get there, your child will be forced to sit out. When picking attractions students will be able to do one of each or two of either should they opt to do two attractions. Please note that if a student is participating in only one attraction, they will be able to watch, eat or play in the arcade while others are participating in a second attraction.

***Admission, supervision and transportation are included in each field trip fee. Food, souvenirs, arcade games, etc. are all an additional expense to be paid by the student. Chaperones are not responsible for loaning money and should not be asked to do so. Please send your child with an appropriate amount of additional spending money if necessary.

Special Days (TBA): Tournaments and Competitions, Wacky Olympics, Freeze Pop Fridays, Ice Cream Day, Movie Days.

Elementary students, grades 5 and younger should plan to enter the school through the main Pratt Elementary School entrance. Grades 6-12 should enter the building behind the high school near the pool and fitness center. We will provide supervision for students to walk from the elementary gym and cafetorium to the HS area and back. Bike racks are available between the MS and Pratt entrances as well as near the HS gym entrance. Students taking music lessons will be able to enter the building at the outside band room entrance or from the above mentioned areas. In addition to posters around the various Summer Recreation locations, along with take home flyers, we'll use www.barkercsd.net/summer to post updates for activities, schedule changes or new information as it becomes available. Should we need to inform everyone of a major change, a note will be sent home with all students.
