

San Jacinto County Local Area Go Texan Scholarship Application 2010

DEADLINE

Applications must be received by your school counselor no later than the close of business, on April 9, 2010.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, an applicant must be active in 4-H or FFA in San Jacinto County. Student must also attend public school. Students will not be considered who are home schooled or attend a private or parochial school.

RESIDENCY

The applicant must reside in San Jacinto County. Address for applicant must include a physical mailing address and not just a post office box.

CITIZENSHIP

The Applicant must be a citizen of the United States.

ACADEMIC STANDING

The applicant must be a graduating senior ranked in his/her graduating class. Each application must be accompanied by an official transcript showing academic average and grading scale through four years of high school, class size and official ranking of applicant (which must include date of ranking).

GRADUATION

The applicant must graduate during the school year in which he/she applies.

COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

No application will be considered without SAT or ACT test scores. The applicant must have taken either the SAT or ACT college entrance examination prior to the submission of the application and furnish proof of the score. The highest test score may be used for evaluation but scores from different test dates will not be combined.

COLLEGIATE ACCEPTANCE / ENROLLMENT

The applicant must be enrolled or have acceptance from, a college, university or vocational school. No application may be considered from a student who has not been accepted to a college, university or vocational school.

ACTIVITIES

Leadership potential and character of the applicant should be demonstrated through the applicant's responses to the categories of the application detailing school, extracurricular and community activities and achievements.

NARRATIVE

Each applicant must include a typed narrative of no more than 1page (approximately 100 words) on an 8½ X 11 sheet. There is no specific topic or theme; however, the narrative should clearly indicate the importance of a college education and career goals as well as give a personal insight as to the need for the scholarship. Applicant's name must be typed as a heading to the narrative.

REFERENCES

Each applicant must furnish 2 letters of personal reference from persons (other than kin) who are well acquainted with him/her (preferably from a school employee & applicant's employer past or present). References either may be typed or handwritten and should include the name, address and phone number of the person making the recommendation, as well as an indication of the person's relationship to the applicant. These letters must be attached to the application. Reference letters should not exceed 2 pages in length.

EVALUATION PROCEDURE

For the purpose of evaluation of applicants, a scholarship committee will review all applications. Applicants are evaluated on the basis of academics, character and leadership.
