Mayflower College rules – Students must abide by the following rules at the Mayflower College:

- a) Students must abide by the **Mayflower College rules** and **Homestay rules** stated in the Junior Activity Course rules and Information document.
- b) Attendance is compulsory for all lessons and activities. Absence from Mayflower College will only be authorised for health reasons or with written permission from a parent/ guardian.
- c) Smoking, the consumption of alcohol, and the taking of controlled drugs is strictly forbidden for students under 18 in the UK.
- d) Students must return to their homestay by the times stated in the **Homestay rules** in the General Information for students on the Junior Activity course, except when they are attending activities organised by Mayflower College.

Any infringement of these rules may result in students being sent home early at their own expense, without refund of any fees. The Mayflower College reserves the right to ask a student to leave because of misconduct (unacceptable behaviour), non payment of fees or non-attendance and be subject to disciplinary procedures. All students and staff at the Mayflower College are expected to show respect at all times. The following behaviour is not acceptable: harassment, bullying, actual or threats of violence, damage to personal property and verbal abuse based on racial, sexual or religious differences.

Mayflower College Discipline procedures

1. Verbal warning (by teacher and/or group leader).
2. Verbal warning by Director of Studies / Director
3. Written warning by Director of Studies / Director to students and copy to parents.
4. Final written warning Director of Studies / Director to students and copy to parents
5. Expulsion at the cost of parents (to send student back to their country of origin).

Supervision & Internet access

The supervision of students participating on the Junior Activity Course is shared between the Mayflower College (during lessons and activities) and the homestay provider (evenings and weekends). The Mayflower College will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety and well-being of students on the Junior activity course. Students will have unsupervised access to the internet at Mayflower College and in the homestay. Students will travel independently by public transport to and from all lessons, activities and excursions organised by the Mayflower College.

The Junior activity programme and travel & medical insurance

The inclusive programme of excursions, visits & sports are carefully organised by the school and are supervised by Mayflower College teachers. The Junior activity programme may include coach travel, boat trips and sport, such as football, swimming cycling and tobogganing. We strongly advise that all students have travel insurance and medical insurance which includes winter sports.
