It's Vodacom Funny Festival time again

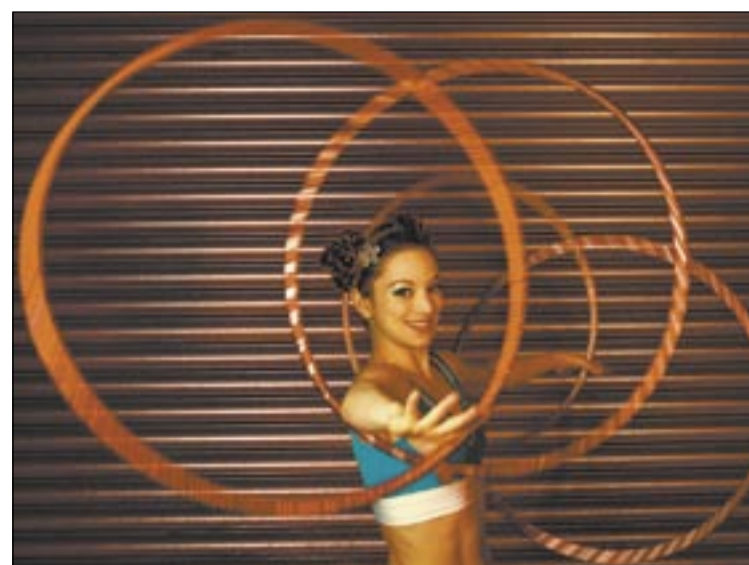
Cape Town's favourite comedy project, the Vodacom Funny Festival is back by popular demand for a month-long season, from June 13 to July 10 at the Baxter Theatre, presenting the best in local and international comedy.

The award-winning production, which has run to full houses since its inception seven years ago, includes comedians from Australia, Switzerland, Korea, New Zealand, England and South Africa.

Over the years, the Festival has developed into a variety project with a strong emphasis on specialty acts. This year is no different and showcases the work of Korea's top magic comedienne, New Zealand's sensational comic export, England's most original piano player, Australia's top hula-hoop performer and the Swiss musical comedy duo, Full House.

Combined with the comic genius and courage of Carl Wastie, the insightful brilliance of Eugene Khoza and the local flavour of Shimmy Isaacs, the show is hosted by the effervescent presence of the best comic host in the country, Alan Committie.

The stand-up comedy revolution in the UK that vaulted comics into stardom across the globe, creating TV greats who have gone on to become radio and TV show hosts, has continued its development, which has kept the art form at the forefront of the entertainment industry. The major international comedy festivals such as Edinburgh, Montreal and Melbourne have all

witnessed a growth in the comedy/cabaret genre and the Funny Festival is a local indication of that growth. For example, New Zealand comedian, "The boy with tape on his face" created a sensation in Edinburgh and Melbourne last year, winning numerous awards, whilst piano maestro England's Kev Orkian, fresh off West End musicals into the comedy industry, has made him one of the most sought after acts on the continent.

Together with Swiss duo, Full House, a veteran act that headlines at most of the European festivals, Australian Kalki, the hula girl and Korea's famous magician Miss Ro, the Vodacom Funny Festival is rich in comedic cabaret acts.
