8. Earnest Money:

The bidder shall deposit Earnest Money Deposit in the form of Demand form drawn on **State Bank of India** payable at **SBI, Numaligarh Refinery Complex Branch** (Code : 5377). **Tender without earnest money will be summarily rejected.**

9. Submission of offer:

Tender with 6 months validity from the date of opening under sealed cover and superscribing the name of the work and date of opening will be received at the Commercial Department of Numaligarh Refinery Limited, Numaligarh by the time and date mentioned above. If the last date of receipt of tender happens to be a non-working day, the last date will be the next working day at the aforesaid time.

10. Scope of work and Supply:

The scope of work & supply of this work will be in accordance with the Tender document, Special Conditions of Contract (SCC), Schedule of Rates and as per the direction of Engineer-in-charge.

List of items to be issued to the contractor on chargeable basis:-

a) OP Cement : Rs.374/-per bag of 43 grade

11. Rate:

Rate should be quoted both in figures and words as per enclosed Schedule of Rates of Priced Bid.

12. Security deposit:

Successful agency has to submit Security Deposit as per GCC of NRL. A sum of 10% of the accepted value for the post warrantee of the job shall be deposited by the agency as security deposit. This may be deposited initially at 2½% (Two & Half Percent) of contract value as Initial Security Deposit within ten days from the date of receipt and acknowledgement of the work order. The balance 7½% (Seven & Half Percent) will be recovered in installments from bills against work done. Alternately, the agency, may in their option deposit the full amount of 10% (Ten Percent) of the order value towards the Security Deposit.

13. Measurement of work

Payment will be made on the basis of joint measurements, taken by the contractor and certified by Engineer-in-charge.

14. **Terms of payment:**

Payment shall be made monthly against the work done during the preceding month on pro-rata basis based on certification made for payment by Engineer-in-Charge.

Further break-up of payment terms if deemed necessary shall be decided by the E-I-C. The above payments are subject to deductions towards security deposit, income tax, WCT(VAT) and other recoveries as applicable as per terms of the contract.

15. **Penalty Clause:** As per GCC.

16. **Defect Liability Period :** 12 (twelve) months.

17. **Price, Taxes, Duties:**

Without prejudice to stipulations in General Conditions of Contract, the bidder should quote firm prices inclusive of all taxes, duties, sales tax on works contract and other levies on which no variation will be allowed. **However, the quoted price will be exclusive of Service Tax. Service Tax as applicable will be loaded by NRL.**

Service tax shall be reimbursed by owner at actual against submission of invoices. However, statutory variations in taxes & duties such as excise duty, VAT, sales tax, service tax and other levies on finished goods during the Contractual completion period only will be on Owner's account. If there is delay beyond contractual completion period for reasons attributable to Contractor, any increase in taxes & duties will be borne by the Contractor and any decrease shall be passed on to Owner.

Bidder has to opt for service tax as per option I & option II as provided in Annexure D of price bid.

1. *The OPTION-I is under Rule 2A (i) of Service Tax (Determination of Value) Second Amendment Rules, 2012 notified vide Notification No 24/2012-ST dated 20.06.12. The **value of service portion in the execution of a works contract** shall be equivalent to the gross amount charged for the works contract less the value of property in goods transferred in the execution of the said works contract. The Value of Transfer of property means the supply portion plus VAT on that supply portion. For example, if the bid price is say Rs 100/ out of which the value of supply portion is Rs 50/ and VAT on the Supply is Rs 7/ then value of service portion will be Rs 43 ie (100-(50+ 7)).*
2. *The Option –II is under Rule 2A (ii) of Service Tax (Determination of Value) Second Amendment Rules, 2012 notified vide Notification No 24/2012-ST dated 20.06.12. Where the Service portion of the Works Contract is unable to determine under Option –I as mentioned in Point 1. above , then the **value of Service Portion in the execution of a works** will be determined as **40% of the Total Amount Charged (Here the total amount charged is the Bid Price as in the Contract does not have free Issue material)***
3. *Amount of Service Tax shall not be included by the Bidder in their quoted price and the same shall be reimbursed by owner at actual against submission of invoices under Rule 4A of Service Tax Rules, 1994 as per provision in bidding document. **This Service Tax component shall be loaded for evaluation.***

4. Bidder shall furnish duly filled in Annexure D in all respects along with his price part.
5. However, Bidder is required to furnish 'Annexure X' indicating the Option Opted for 'Option I' or "Option II" as per column (c) of Annexure X

18. Other terms and conditions:

- (a) Transfer of tender documents issued to one shortlisted bidder to another is not permissible. Further, tender containing uncalled for remarks or any additional conditions are liable to be rejected.
- (b) The management of NRL does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender, and reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reason thereof.
- (c) Variation in the value of the work will not vitiate the tender agreement.
- (d) The contractor will have to abide by the existing laws applicable to contract works and co-operate with other contractors working at site and will not cause hindrance to other works.
- (e) The contractor shall observe all labour and other statutory rules and regulation of State/Central Govt. in force including the Safety and Environmental rules & regulations. In case of any violations of such laws, rules & regulations, the cost involvement thereof shall exclusively be borne by the contractor and the company shall have no liability whatsoever on this account.
- (f) The contractor should engage skilled and unskilled labourers preferably from the families of displaced persons to the extent available.
- (g) **CM (T&E), NRL** shall be the Engineer-in-charge of the work and the contractor will have to abide by the instructions of Engineer-in-charge as given from time to time.

- (k) No escalation of contract value, in any form whatsoever will be entertained during the contract period.

- (l) **For applicable labour wage at NRL site & other relevant information regarding labour wages, kindly refer Memorandum of Settlement dated 26-09-2011** arrived between the two Unions and Contractor's Association namely Numaligarh Refinery Workers' Union, Accord Refinery Workers' Union and Numaligarh Refinery New Contractors' Association respectively on wage revision for the Contract workmen engaged in Numaligarh Refinery Limited, in the Office of the Conciliation Officer and Assistant Labour Commissioner (Central), Dibrugarh. - (m) No mobilisation advance will be paid to the contractor for execution of this work.
- (n) Insurance shall be effected for all employees of the contractor, engaged in the performance of the subject job. (Refer clause 104.1 (ii) of GCC).
- (o) **The contractor is required to obtain** labour license under Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970 & **PF registration number on awarding the contract.** The present rate of PF is 12% (Refer Clause 107.2 of GCC)
- (p) The contractor will not engage minor labour below 18 (eighteen) years of age under any circumstances. The contractor will further comply with the provisions of the following act and indemnify the company against all claims, which may arise out of the following Acts, & Rules framed thereunder:

1. Work has to be executed at residential colony of CISF. Hence, jobs have to be executed without disturbance to residents and other activities of the colony.
2. Proper cleaning of site has to be ensured by the contractor on daily basis during execution.
3. If any damage is caused to existing property (fixed or movable) during execution of the job, the same has to be rectified by the contractor at his own cost.
4. Entry would be permitted to contractor or his employees with valid gate passes only, which should be produced whenever asked for by any concerned officials / security staff.
5. Technical specifications for the jobs shall be as per SOR item description / applicable Indian standards / APWD / CPWD specifications.

 - d) Single point construction water and electrical power shall be provided by NRL on free of charge subjected to availability. Contractor will have to make their own arrangement to tap power and water from the nearby source provided by NRL. Further, contractor may make their own arrangement for construction water & power in case of interruption in supply of these facilities by NRL. Any claim by contractor for delay in execution of the job due to disruption in water & power supply by NRL shall not be entertained.
14. Other Important Conditions:
 - i. Site shall be handed over to the Contractor on the day of Kick off meeting.
 - ii. Mobilization has to be started within fifteen (15) days of site handover otherwise NRL has the right to exercise the option for offloading the job at 'risk and cost' of selected bidder.
 - iii. Contract agreement, Insurance policies etc. has to be submitted prior to starting of the job.
 - iv. Contractor cannot sublet the job to other agency / contractor without prior permission in writing from NRL.

The Contractor will not be entitled to raise any objection to any such arbitrator on the ground that the arbitrator is an Officer of the COMPANY or that he has dealt with the matters to which the contract relates or that in the course of his duties as an Officer of the COMPANY he had expressed views on all or any other matters in dispute or difference. In the event of the arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason, the Managing Director as aforesaid at the time of such transfer, vacation of office or inability to act may in the discretion of the Managing Director designate another person to act as arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the agreement to the end and intent that the original Arbitrator shall be entitled to continue the arbitration proceedings notwithstanding his transfer or vacation of office as an Officer of the COMPANY if the Managing Director does not designate another person to act as arbitrator on such transfer, vacation of Office or inability of original arbitrator. Such persons shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the point at which it was left by his predecessor.
