1. Objective

The objective of these Regulations is to prescribe—

- (a) the form of application for registration as a nurse;
- (b) the form of search warrants; and
- (c) the particulars to be included in the register and certificates of registration—

for the purposes of the Nurses Act 1993.

2. Authorising provision

These Regulations are made under section 93 of the **Nurses Act 1993**.

3. Definition

In these Regulations—

"Act" means the Nurses Act 1993.

4. Form of application for registration

For the purposes of section 5(2)(a) of the Act, the prescribed form is that set out in Schedule 1.

5. The register

For the purposes of section 17(3)(c) of the Act, the following information is the prescribed information—

(a) the address of the person;

(b) her or his professional qualifications;

- (c) the date of her or his initial registration;
- (d) her or his registration number.

6. Certificate of registration

For the purposes of section 18(2)(b) of the Act, the following information is the prescribed information—

- (a) the name of the person registered;
- (b) the division of the register in which she or he is registered;
- (c) the period for which the certificate of registration is valid; and
- (d) the date the certificate was issued.

7. Form of search warrant

For the purposes of section 88(2) of the Act, the prescribed form is that set out in Schedule 2.
