

TI-83 Plus Programs for TSbs

Handheld Software Applications (Apps) are programs you can download to your TI graphing handheld, similar to software programs you download to a computer.

What you need:

- TI-83 Plus or TI-83 Plus Silver Edition with version 1.13 or higher of the operating system software
- Computer with Windows 95/98/2000/XP, Windows NT, or Apple Mac OS 7.1 or higher installed
- TI-GRAPH LINK computer-to-calculator cable
- TI-GRAPH LINK software that is compatible with the TI-83 Plus or TI Connect software. To install TI Connect or get TI connect Software online click on this link. Locating the Apps on this CD:

Open the "**ti_apps.zip**" to access the files with the TI Apps. Save them onto your computer.

How to put the Apps onto your TI handheld device:

Windows

1. Connect a TI-GRAPH LINK cable between the computer and your TI handheld device.
2. From the TI Connect Home Screen, click on Device Explorer. The software will automatically detect the type of connected TI device and allow you to view the contents of your device in a tree directory.
3. From the Device Explorer, click on the Windows Explorer icon (a closed file folder with the magnifying glass).
4. Browse to the location of the Apps.
5. Click on the file and drag it to TI Connect software and drop it into the Device Explorer window. You will see the file being transferred to your device.
6. Press the blue "**APPS**" key to check out your new functionality.

Macintosh

1. Connect a TI-GRAPH LINK cable between the computer and your TI handheld device.
2. Turn on your TI device and make sure it is on the home screen.
3. Start TI Connect software for Macintosh and establish a connection with your TI device.
4. Choose Connection from the menu bar.
5. Click on your device type in the list displayed.
6. Select the computer port.
7. Click Connect. The device window is displayed.
8. Browse to the location of the Apps.
9. Drag the application file you downloaded to the device window. The Sending window displays the progress as the file(s) are sent to your TI handheld.
10. Press the blue "**APPS**" key to check out your new functionality.
