

# Leadership Honors

## Application Materials Fall 2009

### **Purpose**

Leadership Honors are awarded to individuals upon graduation in order to recognize and honor their leadership contributions to the University of Alaska Anchorage while maintaining academic excellence. Leadership activities must enhance the educational mission of UAA, but more importantly, offer other students the opportunity to grow and excel. Involvement must promote individual and collective growth, thereby enhancing student life at UAA. Recipients of UAA Leadership Honors are bestowed crimson honor cords and are commemorated at the spring Commencement ceremony.

### Criteria for Eligibility

- Currently enrolled in at least three credits at the University of Alaska Anchorage and in good disciplinary standing
- Minimum of 3.0/4.0 cumulative UAA GPA (at time of application)
- On-going leadership involvement at UAA for four semesters if receiving a bachelor's degree, or two semesters if receiving other degrees or certificates
  - The student's involvement may include memberships with campus groups, coordinating events on campus, holding campus job or being appointed or elected to a leadership position with an organization, board, or committee
  - O The student's involvement must have contributed to the improvement of student life on campus (i.e.: The student identified a need and filled it. They did not just watch from the sidelines, but instead made a significant difference by their involvement).
- Applicants must be graduating in the semester that they apply
- Submitted a complete application

### Awarding Process

- The Leadership Honors Selection Committee is composed of two faculty/staff members and two students *not* applying for Leadership Honors.
- Applicants who meet the criteria for eligibility are not automatically guaranteed Leadership Honors. The committee reviews applicants on the merit of their involvement and how it enhanced student life.

#### Application Deadline

To be considered for Leadership Honors, a complete application must be received by Student Life and Leadership in Student Union 218 by **5pm on October 23, 2009.**

Please return your completed, signed letter of recommendation to the student applicant. Letters should be provided to the student directly and not enclosed in envelopes. The student's application will be considered incomplete if your letter is not included with his and/or her application packet.
