## RETIRED EMPLOYEE STATEMENT CONCERNING APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT WITH APPALACHIAN STATE UNIVERSITY

It is my understanding that North Carolina's *State Personnel Manual* describes the State's policy with respect to temporary appointments of retired employees for a term of more than twelve months as follows:

[Such an] appointment [is] for a limited term, normally not to exceed three to six months, to a . . . temporary position. . . . If retired employees sign a statement that they are not available for nor seek permanent employment, they may have temporary appointments for more than twelve months. "Retired" is defined as drawing a retirement income and/or social security benefits.

Employees with a temporary appointment do not receive leave, total state service credit, health benefits, retirement credit, severance pay, or priority reemployment consideration.

State Personnel Manual, Employment and Records, Section 3, Page 3 (August 1, 1995).

- 1. I wish to be considered for employment with Appalachian State University on a temporary appointment of more than twelve months.
- 2. I am drawing a retirement income and/or social security benefits.
- 3. I am not available for, nor do I seek, permanent employment.
- 4. I understand that, if I receive a temporary appointment to work at Appalachian State University, I will not receive leave, total state service credit, health benefits, retirement credit, severance pay, or priority reemployment consideration.
- 5. I also understand that, if I am receiving retirement benefits under the North Carolina Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System ("TSERS"), the amount of my earnings as a temporary employee may affect my retirement allowance.
