

2012 7th Grade Application

Thank you for your interest in the Barrett Summer Scholars Program at Arizona State University. This packet contains information, instructions, and forms necessary to complete the application process. <u>It is preferred that you use this</u> packet as a worksheet to help you complete and submit an online application through the program's website at www.asu.edu/barrettsummer. If you are not able submit a Barrett Summer Scholars application online, you may complete this packet and submit it by mail, per the instructions below.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Barrett Summer Scholars (BSS) is a rigorous academic program that provides a residential college experience for gifted 7th, 8th, and 9th graders. Through BSS, participants will experience a summer program designed specifically for very bright students with high academic abilities. There will be two separate residential sessions offered: a one-week session for current 7th graders at the ASU West campus and a three-week session for 8th and 9th grade students at the Tempe campus.

This application is for the 7th Grade Session at the West campus from Sunday, July 8 to Friday, July 13, 2012.

Participants benefit from the program's setting at Arizona State University, the New American University – a public research institution with an unparalleled commitment to excellence, access and impact. This environment allows students to learn and explore the ASU campuses, attend presentations and events created exclusively for BSS and discover career interests through engaging class activities.

The program boasts a distinctive living-learning setting. This encourages academic enrichment and intellectual discovery, which inspires participants to reach their fullest academic potential. All activities are monitored and supervised by BSS staff members who reside in the residence hall with students.

COURSE TOPICS

Once the application has been received and the student has been selected as a participant, he/she will be able to select an elective course with an emphasis in science and/or mathematics. As space is limited in each elective course, participants will be placed in one of their top three choices. All participants will also take a Required Course called *Logic* & *Reasoning*. Examples of past course topics include the following:

Real World Math Applications
 Math in Geography
 Math World Influences
 Math in Medicine

PROGRAM FEE

The program fee for the 7th Grade Session is \$500. This covers tuition, books, room, meals, and transportation & fees for field trips. A \$25 non-refundable deposit is included in the program fee. <u>The program fee and the \$25 deposit are due AFTER notification of admission into the program.</u>

SCHOLARSHIP

Full or partial scholarships are available on an application basis to students who demonstrate financial need. Interested applicants must complete the Scholarship Application (on page 2 of the application) in order to be considered for a scholarship. Scholarships awarded will not cover the \$25 deposit.

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APPLICANT SELECTION INFORMATION

Eligibility

Gifted students from Arizona schools who meet all of the following requirements are eligible to apply:

- Test score in the 97th percentile or above on a state board approved test for the identification of gifted students in Arizona (visit <u>www.ade.az.gov/asd/gifted</u> for a list of state-approved exams)
- o Enrollment in the 7th grade during the 2011-2012 school year

Gifted Examination

Each applicant should check with his/her school or district to learn more about his/her gifted exam results. Qualifications in any one of the areas tested will be accepted for eligibility. Test score results must be submitted with Teacher Recommendation portion of application.
