These are fast roads (40-45 mph posted speed limits, faster in reality) that many cyclists would be afraid to use. Expanding the sidewalk ~~parallel~~ parallel to the frontage roads by the 3 feet you would add to the outside lane would be a better idea. An 8 foot sidewalk, marked for dual pedestrian/bike use, with cyclists yielding to pedestrians, would do far more to increase bike traffic. If we want to have bikes on streets, we can have dual use lanes on lower traffic, parallel streets.
