) **ORDER RE: MAILED NOTICE**

) **(DELINQUENCY)**

NOW, the Court finds that an adjudicatory hearing held pursuant to Iowa Code Section 232.47 has been scheduled to determine whether the child in interest did commit the delinquent act(s) alleged in the Petition. The Court is further advised that the child's non-custodial parent to whom service of notice of this hearing must be made resides outside the State of Iowa and is beyond normal service of process within this State. The Court does have a last known address for the child's non-custodial parent. The Court therefore finds that personal service of notice of the adjudicatory hearing upon the child's non-custodial parent is impracticable and that service should be made by certified mail to the said parent's last known address.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that notice of the adjudicatory hearing herein shall be served upon _____, the child's non-custodial parent, by certified mail addressed to the said parent's last known address, said service being made not less than five (5) days prior to the date set for hearing.

Clerk to provide a copy of this order to child, parents, counsel of record, JCS, and case scheduler.
