TEMPORARY ORDER OF NO CONTACT

NOW, on this ____ day of _____, 200__, this matter comes before the Court by way of the State's Application for Temporary Order of No Contact, and the Court having considered the Application, the Affidavit, and the legal file herein finds that there is probable cause to believe that the child(ren) in interest has been physically abused and/ or neglected (sexually abused) by _____ and that his/her presence in the immediate area of the child(ren)'s residence presents a danger to the child(ren)'s life, physical, emotional or mental health. The Court further finds that since the State is the applicant in the proceedings currently before the Court that pursuant to Rule 1.207 of the Iowa Rules of Civil Procedure that posting of Bond under Rule 1.1508 is unnecessary.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there shall be no contact whatsoever between _____, the child(ren) in interest, and _____, the alleged perpetrator, pending further Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that _____ refrain from visiting, seeing, speaking to communicating with, or being in the immediate vicinity of _____ and his/her residential dwelling at _____ or wherever the child is located.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the _____ County Sheriff shall serve a copy of this Order and the State's application upon _____. A willful violation of this Order shall constitute contempt and be punished accordingly. Any party aggrieved by this Order may seek relief from the Order by petitioning the Court pursuant to Iowa Rule of Civil Procedure 1.1509. The necessity of a bond is hereby waived.

Clerk shall provide a copy of this order to County Sheriff, County Attorney, and Department of Human Services.
