**ORDER FOR MODIFICATION OF  
DELINQUENCY DISPOSITION**

BE IT REMEMBERED that there was filed a Motion for Modification of Disposition to provide for a less/equally/more restrictive disposition. There has also been filed by all parties and counsel of record Waiver of Notice and Hearing and Consent to Entry of Order whereby the parties have stipulated to the modification requested, waived notice and hearing on the request, or ten days have passed since the filing of the motion for modification and no party has requested a hearing and asked the court to enter an order modifying the disposition as requested without further hearing.

Based upon the foregoing, the court finds good cause to modify the present dispositional order as requested for the reasons set forth in the Motion for Modification and to enter an order providing for a less/equally/more restrictive disposition. Reasonable efforts \_\_\_ [a] to avoid or eliminate the need for removal of the child from his/her home; \_\_\_ [b] to reunify the child with his parent(s) have been made. If the child is removed, a determination is made that continuation of the child in the child's home is contrary to the child's welfare. Said modification is the least restrictive disposition available in the circumstances.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:**

1. That the dispositional order entered \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_, is hereby modified to provide as below set forth.
2. That custody of \_\_\_\_\_, the child in interest, is hereby placed with \_\_\_\_\_ for purposes of placement in \_\_\_\_\_ with continuing supervision by \_\_\_\_\_ Judicial District Juvenile Court Services. This dispositional order shall remain in force until the child is eighteen years of age except as otherwise modified or terminated.
3. That Juvenile Court Services shall file a case permanency plan [probation terms] in furtherance of this order.
4. That this dispositional order should be reviewed pursuant to Iowa Code Section 232.54 at a hearing to be scheduled by the court administrative office within six months from the entry of this order.

Clerk to send a copy of this order to child, parents, counsel of record, Juvenile Court Services, and Case Scheduler.
