Overview:

Nearly 50 years ago, President John F. Kennedy challenged a new generation to “ask not what your country can do for you-ask what you can do for your country”. His words struck deep into the soul of a young man who would later become one of the first students to attend Valencia College. Bill Castellano always took an active interest in government and his community. From serving in the Student Government Association and as a founder of the Valencia Alumni Association after graduating to retiring as one of the most admired and respected government professors, he always challenged the next generation he met to rise and meet the challenges of the man who inspired him to be a true civic leader.

Professor Castellano’s ability to encourage students to share their true talents for the common good of their community will be his legacy. He was a guiding force for students and the Valencia College family for over 40 years. In remembrance of his outstanding contributions to our community, the Bill Castellano Civic Leadership Scholarship will be awarded to a student who exhibits the leadership skills and overwhelming desire to become a future civic leader. This scholarship will allow those who will never have the opportunity to meet him the ability to carry on his passion and love of government and true civic leadership.

Eligibility Criteria:

The student must:

- ☐ be degree seeking and have completed at least 9 credit hours at Valencia College
- ☐ have a minimum overall 2.5 GPA
- ☐ have successfully completed POS 2041 U.S. Government with a “C” or higher
- ☐ have demonstrated a commitment to school, leadership and community service and/or have actively participated in a government campaign

1. Each candidate must submit this application packet, completed and to be received no later than 5:00 p.m., Monday, October 3, 2011.

- ☐ A Resume (not to exceed two pages - recommend visiting the Career Center on any campus for review)
- ☐ Two letters of recommendation (one from Valencia staff or faculty and one from community organization where you have volunteered)
- ☐ Essay (minimum of 400 words and not to exceed 500 words)
