

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 305

DIGEST OF SB 305 (Updated February 21, 2006 11:44 am - DI 96)

Citations Affected: IC 9-13; IC 9-21; IC 20-27.

Synopsis: Special purpose buses. Requires a special purpose bus to stop before crossing railroad tracks. Provides that a school bus or special purpose bus may not be operated with passengers on board if an exit or emergency exit window is obstructed, and makes a violation a Class B infraction. Allows the state school bus committee to adopt rules concerning special purpose buses.

Effective: July 1, 2006.

SECTION 2. IC 9-21-12-11, AS AMENDED BY P.L.231-2005, SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006]: Sec. 11. (a) A person who violates section 5, 6, or 7 of this chapter commits a Class C infraction.

- (b) A person who knowingly or intentionally violates section 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, or 17 of this chapter commits a Class C misdemeanor.
- (c) A person who violates section 18 of this chapter commits a Class B infraction.

SECTION 3. IC 9-21-12-17, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION 31, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2006]: Sec. 17. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), before crossing any railroad track at grade, the driver of a school bus or special purpose bus carrying a passenger shall stop the bus within
