EDWARD FLYNN, JR. : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of January 7, 2010, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit Edward Flynn, Jr. had forwarded. After pleading guilty to Endangering the Welfare of a Child, the Court ordered Flynn to forfeit his teaching certificates. Flynn currently holds a Teacher of the Handicapped certificate, issued in June 1983 and a Learning Disabilities Teacher-Consultant certificate, issued in March 1990.

Flynn agreed to forfeit his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of January 7, 2010, the Board voted to accept Flynn's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8*.

Accordingly, on this 7th day of January 2010 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Edward Flynn Jr.'s Teacher of the Handicapped and Learning-Disabilities Teacher-Consultant certificates be effective immediately.
