Subject: 45/45 Hour Programs for Language Arts/Literacy and Mathematics for

Elementary K-5 Alternate Route Candidates

Changes recently enacted pursuant to N.J.A.C.6A:9-8.3(b)5 stipulate that:

- Provisional teachers who are holders of an elementary school (K-5) endorsement must complete a
  minimum of 290 hours of formal instruction over two years in a State-approved program of
  formal instruction.
- This instruction must include in the **first calendar year of a teacher's employment** a minimum of 45 hours of study in the teaching of language arts / literacy at the K-5 level and a minimum of 45 hours of study in teaching mathematics at the K-5 level.
- The effective date of this requirement is **October 31, 2009**. [Those candidates who were hired and registered in the Provisional Teacher Program prior to October 31, 2009 are not required to complete this coursework.]
- The fee for each 45 hour class at a regional training center is \$325. For-credit program fees are determined by the college or university.

This instruction will be available throughout the state at regional training centers or through coursework at colleges or universities. A list of approved programs and courses is available on the Office of Licensure and Credentials website at:

Provisional teachers holding an elementary school (K-5) certificate of eligibility may be exempted from completing the 45/45 hours of study if:

• For each area of study, they have completed 45 hours of study in that area within the three years prior to receiving their certificate of eligibility as documented by a Department-approved

alternate route regional training center or through equivalent coursework on the transcript of a regionally accredited four-year college or university. As a result, candidates who are seeking certificates of eligibility may be viable candidates for regional training centers or for college credit courses prior to employment (see attached Verification of Program Completion form for district use); or

• For each area of study, they document the equivalent of at least one-year of successful experience as a full-time teacher during which the subject area is regularly taught, among the other subjects for which a K-5 teacher would be responsible. This experience must take place within the three years prior to receiving their certificate of eligibility and documented by submitting a completed, original form provided by the Office (see attached Verification of Program Completion form for district use when submitting the summative evaluation).

Please note that this requirement also applies to candidates seeking a Teacher of Elementary School with Subject Matter Specialization certificate.

Attached is a verification of program completion form that districts may use to confirm that this requirement has been met. This form is also available as page 8 of the summative evaluation that is posted on the website for PTP forms.
