Oregon Uniform Criminal Jury Instructions now contains 588 instructions and fills two binders.

The Uniform Criminal Jury Instructions Committee has reviewed all the instructions and accounted for changes made by the 2009 Legislature. Every instruction is followed by citations to legal authority (statutes, cases, and other sources) and helpful cross-references to other instructions. The Users' Guide has new sections about *Boots* instructions and inconsistent verdicts. Plus, we've retained the tables of cases and statutes at the back of the book for quick reference.

New instructions include:

- Requirement for Electronic Recording—in cases when the state should have recorded a custodial interview in an aggravated murder or Measure 11 investigation
- Giving False Information to a Peace Officer for Arrest on a Warrant
- Assault in the First and Fourth Degrees of a Pregnant Victim
- Sexual Abuse in the Third Degree—by propelling a dangerous substance
- Aggravated Criminal Driving while Suspended or Revoked

Significantly amended instructions include:

- Precautionary Instructions—new language guards against “Google mistrials” by warning jurors not to use electronic means to communicate or conduct research about the case
- Failure to Report as a Sex Offender—tracks 2009 legislative changes
- Kidnapping in the First Degree—new case law covers many different issues
- Dangerous Offender and Sexually Violent Dangerous Offender—updates make instructions consistent with 2007 legislative changes

Note: Many instructions have new numbers. For your convenience, we've included a table of renumbered instructions.

Criminal Law

With nearly 1,800 pages and more than 4,000 cases, this book has expanded to three volumes of case law, 2005 and 2006 statutory law, and rules, including: aftermath of *Blakely* regarding a court's ability to impose a sentence above the standard range set forth in the sentencing guidelines; aftermath of *Crawford* regarding the admissibility of testimonial hearsay; and a new chapter dealing with the exclusionary rule. The 2006 legislative supplement covers: enhancement facts and sentencing-phase jury trials; drug crimes; disorderly conduct in the first degree; right of movie theater to detain people suspected of recording a film; appearance by simultaneous electronic transmission; conditional discharge statute; restitution statutes; dangerous-offender statutes; firearm-minimum statute; law on victim impact evidence in death penalty cases; and definition of victim. The supplement also includes a revised chapter on criminal forfeiture.
