**Spill Reporting Form Guidance** 

**JFK Spill Reporting Form:** The attached Spill Reporting Form shall be completed by tenants and contractors and includes procedures and protocols for spill events. Tenants and contractors shall report any discharge of petroleum greater than 5 gallons to NYSDEC within 2 hours of discovery, and notify NYSDEC and/or the National Response Center for releases of a reportable quantity of a hazardous substance.

**Port Authority Spill Reporting Notifications:** Tenants and contractors are required to notify Port Authority Central Police, Operations, and Environmental Services of any spill event.

**Instructions:** Tenants and contractors shall complete an electronic copy (or print and scan a completed copy) of the JFK Spill Report Form and submit to Ms. Denise A Branch, Manager, Environmental Services Unit and Mr. Blake Hamilton of Malcolm Pirnie, Inc. (contact information provided at right) within one (1) business day of the spill identifying the event date/time, location, type of spill, response, gallons spilled, cause/reason for spill leak, and recommended remedial action.
