Executive Summary

Senate Bill 140, 80th Texas Legislature, directed the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) and the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) to conduct a joint study of the feasibility of providing free or discounted immunizations to economically disadvantaged students enrolled in health professional degree programs. The report is THECB's and DSHS's response to that directive.

This study examined:

1. A needs assessment for immunizations concerning students enrolled in health professional degree programs:
 - The number of students enrolled in health degree programs at community colleges, universities, and health-related institutions in Texas for academic years 2004-2006;
 - The number of disadvantaged students enrolled in health degree programs in fall 2006, as determined by the number of Pell grant recipients; and
 - A comparison of the ages of student's attending health degree programs with the state's requirements for immunization to determine the number of students enrolled in health programs that should already have received the mandatory immunization requirements.
2. Access to immunization services for students enrolled in health degree programs:
 - Options for student's to receive immunizations free or at a discount; and
 - The state's Texas Vaccines for Children Program (TVFC), the Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program, and the purchasing of vaccinations on the State of Texas contract for institutions of higher education with a student health clinic.

Key findings

- Approximately 114,000 students enrolled in health degree programs at Texas public community colleges, universities, and health-related institutions in fall 2006, a 7 percent increase from 2004.
- Of that number, approximately 33 percent of those students are economically disadvantaged.
- Students who are underinsured, uninsured, Native American, or Native Alaskan, and students on Medicaid/Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), who are age 18 and younger, can receive mandatory vaccinations at no cost or low cost at TVFC provider offices.
- Based on the estimated number of students needing vaccination (see chart on p.5-7) and the current Center for Disease Control (CDC) price for the currently recommended

adult vaccines for this group (p.8), the THECB estimates the cost to the state to be \$1,625,601.

- DSHS's Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program allows students who are underinsured, uninsured, Native American or Native Alaskan, and students on Medicaid/CHIP to receive immunizations at no cost or low cost. Vaccines are administered throughout Texas at local health departments and DSHS public clinics.
- Both state and federal funds are used to fund the Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program. State appropriations tend to be consistent over time. However, Federal funds (317) are appropriated annually by the United States Congress and are subject to change. Childhood vaccinations are a priority for the State of Texas.
- Public entities, including institutions of higher education that have student health clinics, can purchase vaccines from the State of Texas contract, which provides a lower cost compared to privately purchased vaccines.

Conclusions

The DSHS's newly implemented Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program can ease the financial burden for economically disadvantaged students enrolled in health professional degree programs at Texas institutions of higher education. The program allows students to receive required immunizations at local health department and DSHS public clinics located throughout Texas. However, because the program is federally funded through discretionary funds from the CDC, ongoing state funding would better ensure the continuation of the program. Should the state decide to provide this funding, THECB staff estimate the cost of funding the program for the number of students currently enrolled who are disadvantaged to be \$1,625,601.

Because the program is new, it is important that program advisors and admissions counselors of community colleges, universities, and health-related institutions be aware of its existence. Uninsured or underinsured students planning to attend health programs need to be made aware of the availability of the Adult Safety-Net program so they can start their vaccination series prior to delivering direct patient care. Purchasers for institutions of higher education that have student health clinics should be made aware that vaccinations can be purchased on the State of Texas contract at a lower cost.

Because of the public safety concerns for students, and the potential effects on the pipeline of workforce education students to be able to work in high need career areas, it is recommended that the issue of certificate and continuing education students receiving immunizations be further studied.

Background

To fulfill the requirements of SB 140, 80th Texas Legislature, staff of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) and the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) collaborated to conduct a study of the feasibility of providing immunizations for free or at a discount to economically disadvantaged students enrolled in health professional degree programs at institutions of higher education in Texas. This study identifies the number of students enrolled in health professional degree programs who are economically disadvantaged, explores ways that students could receive required vaccinations for free or at a discount, and estimates costs to the state for vaccination administration to students.

Students enrolled in health professional degree programs are required by the DSHS agency rules to receive certain immunizations prior to providing direct patient care in medical and dental facilities. The rules also apply to veterinary students whose coursework involves direct contact with animals or animal remains. DSHS agency rules are specified in the Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Section 97.64.

In Texas, the rising cost of both health care and tuition are well documented. Since tuition was deregulated by the Texas State Legislature in 2003, the statewide average for statutory and designated tuition has increased 58 percent, from an average of \$1,315 for a course load of 15 semester credit hour (SCH) to \$2,080.

In addition to rising educational expenses, the cost of health care is prohibitive for some students enrolled in health programs. A 2007 U.S. Census report indicates that Texas leads the nation in the percentage of its population who lack health insurance; an estimated 25 percent of the Texas population is uninsured. A March 2008 report to the U.S. Senate Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions suggests that approximately 20 percent of college students aged 18 through 23 (1.7 million persons) were uninsured in 2006. Students without health insurance are often part-time students, older students, students from racial and ethnic minorities, or low-income students. Over half of the colleges and universities nationwide offer student health insurance plans for year 2007-2008, however, the plans' benefits varied for levels of coverage and costs.

Definitions

Definitions for the following terms were derived from the Texas Education Code and sections of the Texas Administrative Code pertaining to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, the Department of State Health Services, the U.S. Department of Education, and other similar sources.

- ***Institution of Higher Education***

Any public technical institution, public junior college, public senior college or university, medical or dental unit, public state college, or other agency of higher education.

- ***Federal Pell Grant Program***

A federal program that provides need-based grants to low-income undergraduate and certain post-baccalaureate students to promote access to postsecondary education.

Students may use their grants at any one of approximately 5,400 participating postsecondary institutions nationwide. Grant amounts depend on the student's expected family contribution (EFC); the cost of attendance (as determined by the institution); the student's enrollment status (full-time or part-time); and whether the student attends for a full academic year or less. Students may not receive Federal Pell Grant Funds from more than one school at a time. Financial need is determined by the U.S. Department of Education using a standard formula, established by Congress, to evaluate the financial information reported on the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) and to determine the family EFC. The fundamental elements in this standard formula are the student's income (and assets if the student is independent), the parents' income and assets (if the student is dependent), the family's household size, and the number of family members (excluding parents) attending postsecondary institutions. The EFC is the sum of: (1) a percentage of net income, and (2) a percentage of net assets. Different assessment rates and allowances are used for dependent students, independent students without dependents, and independent students with dependents. After filing a FAFSA, the student receives a Student Aid Report (SAR), or the institution receives an Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR), which notifies the student if he or she is eligible for a Federal Pell Grant.

Important Note

For the purposes of this study, the THECB defines economically disadvantaged students as those students receiving federal aid through the Federal Pell Grant Program as described above. The study does not determine whether the number of students identified as economically disadvantaged are also uninsured or underinsured. The THECB does not collect data on whether or not Pell Grant recipients are insured, underinsured, or not insured.

Immunization Requirements

Statutory Requirements and Agency Rules for Immunizations

The Texas Education Code (TEC), Section 51.933(a) allows institutions of higher education to require immunization against diphtheria, rubeola, rubella, mumps, tetanus,

and poliomyelitis for applicants. TEC, Section 51.933(b) allows DSHS to require immunizations against the diseases listed in Subsection (a) and additional diseases for students at any institution of higher education who are pursuing a course of study in a human or animal health profession. The DSHS Board may require those immunizations for any students in times of an emergency or epidemic in a county where the Commissioner of DSHS has declared such an emergency or epidemic.

The DSHS agency rules as specified in the Texas Administrative Code (TAC), Section 97.64, require certain immunizations for students enrolled in health-related courses, which will involve direct patient contact in medical or dental facilities. The DSHS agency rules also apply to veterinary students whose coursework involves direct contact with animals or animal remains. These rules require the following vaccinations:

- Students must show acceptable evidence of one dose of tetanus vaccine within the past 10 years;
- Students who were born on or after January 1, 1957, must show, prior to patient contact, acceptable evidence of vaccination of two doses of measles-containing vaccine administered since January 1, 1968;
- Students must show, prior to patient contact, acceptable evidence of vaccination of one dose of rubella vaccine;
- Students born on or after January 1, 1957, must show, prior to patient contact, acceptable evidence of vaccination of one dose of mumps vaccine;
- Students shall receive a complete series of hepatitis B vaccine prior to the start of direct patient care, or show serologic confirmation of immunity to hepatitis B virus;
- Students enrolled in schools of veterinary medicine shall receive a complete primary series of rabies vaccine prior to the start of contact with animals or their remains; and, a booster dose of rabies vaccine every two years unless protective serum antibody levels are documented; and
- Students shall receive two doses of varicella vaccine unless the first dose was received prior to 13 years of age.

The DSHS rules for students in health-degree programs at institutions of higher education are based on current recommendations by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and other medical recommendations.

Methodology

Student Enrollment in Health Professional Degree Programs

The THECB and DSHS staff reviewed the programs listed on the Texas Health Professions Council website. The list was then compared to the Classification of

Instructional Programs (CIP) codes developed by the U.S. Department of Education's National Center for Education Statistics) for health professional degree programs to determine the health professional programs to include in the study. Appendix B contains a list of programs by CIP code included in the study.

Texas institutions of higher education are required to report enrollment data to the THECB every fall. Enrollment data include both students formally enrolled in a program and students who have "declared" a major that are taking prerequisite and academic courses prior to admission into specific programs. An enrollment report was generated (Appendices C, D, and, E), based on the CIP codes for health professional programs by type of institution, as reported to THECB for fall semesters 2004-2006. The number of students enrolled in health professional programs at public community, technical and Lamar state colleges, universities, and health-related institutions has increased by 7 percent over the three-year period from 2004 to 2006. For fall 2006, a total of 113,899 students were enrolled in health professional degree programs.

To determine the number of students enrolled in health professional degree programs who are economically disadvantaged, a report was generated by THECB staff regarding the number of students enrolled in health professional degree programs receiving Pell grants (Appendices F, G and, H) by type of institution. At Texas community, technical and Lamar state colleges, universities, and health-related institutions in Fall 2006, an estimated 37,872 students, or 33 percent of the 113,899 students enrolled in health professional degree programs, were economically disadvantaged, as determined by the students' receipt of a Pell grant.

▪ **Note**

Data regarding the number of economically disadvantaged students enrolled in health professional degree programs are limited. Students already accepted into programs are included as well as are students not yet admitted into programs but who have "declared" their major. Further, students already enrolled may have received required vaccinations.

The DSHS staff looked at data from the Texas Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System and the American Academy of Family Physicians, the vaccination requirements for children and adults, and age of the 37,872 disadvantaged students enrolled in health professional degree programs (Appendix I). From these data, DSHS staff projected the

number of students enrolled in health professional degree programs who should have already received their required immunizations due to Texas school requirements:

- Hepatitis B: students up to age 22 have been previously vaccinated with Hepatitis B vaccine (15-22 year olds are 95 percent covered);
- Measles, Mumps and Rubella: Students up to age 29 have been previously vaccinated with MMR vaccine (15-29 year olds are 95 percent covered);
- Varicella: Students up to age 29 have been previously vaccinated with Varicella vaccine (15-29 year olds are 95 percent covered); and
- Tetanus Toxoid, Reduced Diphtheria Toxoid and Acellular Pertussis (Td/Tdap): Students up to age 17 have been previously vaccinated with Tdap vaccine (15-17 year olds are 95 percent covered).

Options for Students to Receive Vaccinations

Texas Vaccines for Children Program

Texas has participated in the Federal Vaccines for Children Program (VFC) since its inception in 1994. In Texas, the program is called the Texas Vaccines for Children Program (TVFC). The program was initiated by the passage of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993. This legislation guaranteed the provision of vaccines be available at no cost to providers, in order to immunize children (birth - 18 years of age) who meet the eligibility requirements. Today there are more than 6,000 Texas providers enrolled in TVFC. Under TVFC, the following groups of children (birth – 18 years of age) should receive vaccines at no cost or low cost:

- Children who are uninsured or underinsured children,
- Children who are covered by Child Health Insurance Program,
- Children who are of Native American or Native Alaskan heritage, and
- Children on Medicaid.

Any economically disadvantaged student that is 18 years old or younger attending health professional degree programs could participate in the TVFC programs. Vaccinations are administered at local health departments and the Department of Health Services public clinics. Approximately 5,045 students enrolled in health professional degree programs in fall 2006 were age 18 and younger (Appendix I).

DSHS Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program

In August 2007, the Texas DSHS Immunization Program received additional Section 317 funds from the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC) to allow for the implementation of an Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program. Section 317 funding is primarily for childhood vaccinations, and childhood vaccination is a priority for DSHS. The Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program budget consists of federal section 317 funds and state general revenue (GR) funds. The Section 317 vaccine program is a discretionary program. The Immunization Services Division of CDC, as the fiscal manager of the funds, can exercise discretion in determining the amount estimated annually for each grantee. Vaccines purchased with Section 317 funds are intended for underinsured children not able to be served through the Vaccines for Children entitlement program and uninsured and underinsured adults.

The expansion of the Texas DSHS Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program allows for the addition of newly recommended adult vaccines. This vaccine safety net provides a means for uninsured and underinsured adults to receive recommended vaccinations. A map of Texas institutions of higher education, local health departments, and DSHS public clinics is in Appendix J. The adult safety-net vaccines are only available through local health departments (Appendix K) and DSHS public clinics (Appendix L). Private

providers are not authorized to provide TVFC vaccines to adults 19 years of age or older, unless the patient began an immunization series prior to age 19.

Assuming the current adult vaccine costs remain constant and that new adult vaccine products do not become available, the current adult vaccine safety net can provide vaccines to uninsured and underinsured adults.

The current CDC price for the currently recommended adult vaccines for this age group of individuals is as follows:

Each year, Texas will have more students covered for certain vaccinations (i.e., Hepatitis B, Tetanus and Diphtheria Toxoids, Measles, Mumps and Rubella). Texas first required the Hepatitis B vaccine in August 2000 for students who were five years of age (generally in Kindergarten) and students who were 12 years of age (generally in 7th grade). The 12-year-old student who received the Hepatitis B series (3 doses) in order to remain enrolled in a Texas school is now approximately 20 years of age. Using this estimation, students 18-20 years of age are most likely covered with 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine; therefore, they do not need the vaccine in order to attend a health-related program at an institution of higher education in Texas.

The following table shows each vaccine requirement for Texas schools and the year the vaccine was implemented, including an age or grade if applicable:

The process for a student enrolled in a health professional degree program to receive immunizations through the Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program would be for the student to contact a local health department or DSHS public clinic (Appendix J) and request the vaccine required for school attendance. The student must be uninsured or underinsured in order to qualify for the free or discounted vaccine. Clinic hours and availability must be verified by the student by calling the local health department or DSHS public clinic as hours and days available vary by clinic.

Because the Adult Vaccine Safety Net Program has been in existence for less than a year, it is important that potential students, academic counselors, and health program deans and directors become aware of the program. Counselors would be able to direct underinsured or uninsured potential students to local health departments and public clinics throughout the state.

University Health Centers

Each of the required vaccines could be purchased by student health center clinics on the State of Texas contract at a discounted price. Each institution of higher education that is interested in purchasing its own vaccine may contact the DSHS Immunization Branch for guidelines.

Additional Issues for Consideration

This study focuses primarily on the students enrolled in health professional degree programs. However, a large number of students enroll in short-term certificate and

continuing education programs, such as nurse aide and emergency medical technician programs at community colleges. Students enrolled in these programs also provide direct patient care. Students are often able to register and enroll in a program in a short timeframe, which could be just the day before classes start. Also, some of the programs are short-term (less than a semester). The fact that students can enroll just before a program starts often prohibits a student from being able to complete, for example, the required three-shot series required for the Hepatitis vaccine. This has created concern for coordinators of certificate and continuing education programs, especially at community colleges in Texas. Because of these concerns, a series of meetings were conducted by DSHS and THECB staff and stakeholders, as described in Appendix M.

The following summarizes the major issues of concern voiced by college representatives during these meetings:

- Certificate and Continuing Education (CE) programs are more adversely impacted than degree program.
- Duration of some programs is not long enough to complete a vaccination series.
- The cost of vaccine is a burden to economically disadvantaged students.

Purchasers for institutions of higher education that have student health clinics should be made aware that vaccinations can be purchased on the State of Texas contract at a lower cost.

Because of the public safety concerns for students, and the potential effects on the pipeline of workforce education students to be able to work in high need career areas, it is recommended that the issue of certificate and continuing education students receiving immunizations be further studied.

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Appendix A

Senate Bill 140, 80th Texas Legislature

S.B. No. 140

AN ACT

relating to a study of the feasibility of providing immunizations to certain students enrolled in health professional degree programs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. (a) The Department of State Health Services and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall conduct a joint study of the feasibility of providing immunizations without charge or at a discount to economically disadvantaged students enrolled in health professional degree programs at institutions of higher education in this state. The study must examine potential methods of providing those immunizations.

(b) Not later than January 15, 2009, the Department of State Health Services and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall submit to the legislature a joint written report containing the findings of the study and the department and coordinating board's recommendations.

(c) This section expires September 1, 2009.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.



APPENDIX M

Summary of DSHS & THECB Joint Stakeholder Meetings

During the fall of 2006, DSHS and THECB staff met with various stakeholders, including representatives from rural and urban colleges to discuss the issues and challenges colleges are facing with the current immunization requirements for students enrolled in health-related programs. The DSHS and THECB staff met with representatives from urban colleges in the Dallas area and representatives from rural colleges in the Midland area. A meeting was also held in Austin. All representatives at the three locations agreed that immunizations are important for students. Difficulties encountered with implementation of existing DSHS rules were discussed.

Because of the public safety concerns for students, and potential the effects on the pipeline of workforce education students to be able to work in high need career areas, it is recommended that the issue of certificate and continuing education students enrolled in health professional programs be further studied.

Continuing education (CE) Programs Versus Credit Programs

- Credit programs establish deadlines for admission prior to the first day of class for students to complete the required documentation and immunizations before enrolling.
- Some colleges have mandatory Career Advising and Planning (CAP) sessions that emphasize immunization requirements and background checks.
- These procedures are effective and few students attending the sessions are denied enrollment for non-compliance to the requirements.
- CE programs cannot establish the same procedures as the credit programs.
- Students enrolling in CE programs are less likely than credit students to prepare in advance. They typically show up the day of (or one day prior to) the beginning of class.
- Most colleges agreed that credit students are less affected by the immunization rules than continuing education and certificate students.

Program Length (Examples)

- Emergency Medical Technician-Basic (EMT-B) programs are 16 weeks in length.
- Licensed Vocational Nursing certificate programs are 12 months in length.
- Most colleges offer programs that are less than 6 months long.

- Completion of a three-dose series of Hepatitis B vaccine is very difficult, as it takes 4 to 6 months to complete.

Other Issues

- Misinformation on the immunization schedule (i.e., Hepatitis B intervals).
- Inconsistencies with documentation of immunization records.
- Cost of vaccine
 - Ranges from \$30-60/dose
 - Student costs of immunizations, criminal background checks, and drug screens can cost \$300-\$500 per student to complete a health program leading to a job paying \$7-8 per hour. Costs are not covered by financial aid.
- Inconsistency of area physicians timing of immunizations (i.e., hepatitis B vaccine)
 - Twenty-one day intervals to six-month intervals are followed.
 - Refusal of area-providers willing to administer the vaccine in a 4-month time period or to give the third shot.
 - Many schools cited the month/day/year for each vaccine was not documented; instead, "series complete" was written on the record.
- Lack of vaccine from local area health-departments and local providers.
- Limited pool of students.
- Community colleges in rural areas are not able to provide a trained workforce to employers.
 - Some colleges have worked with area employers to cover the vaccine cost.
 - Four-to-six month lag between the second and third immunization doses is too long for employers to wait for student to begin working.
 - Students on government programs, such as Temporary Assistance for Needy Families and Workforce Investment Act Programs must meet timelines that do not allow four to six months to start training. This may cause students to leave the health professions and major in other disciplines.
