5. TENDER VALIDITY

Tender shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 120 days from the date of Tender opening/extended date of opening (if any). Tenders received for shorter validity will be rejected.

6. RATE CONTRACT PERIOD

Two years from the date of issue of rate contract.

7. PURCHASER

8. TENDERER'S ELIGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATIONS

The tenderer shall furnish, as a part of the tender document, following documents establishing their eligibility to tender and qualification to perform the contract if its tender is accepted.

- (A) Latest and valid income tax clearance certificate(ITCC)/ITR (not older than one year as on tender opening date)
- (B) Name and address of bankers with satisfactory bankers report regarding tenderers financial capability for doing business worth Rs.10 lakh(Rupees T en lakhs only) in one year.

- © At least 3 years experience in supply of scientific/technical/medical books, reports and Serials(Indian and Foreign) to large libraries, Government of India libraries. (Attach Certificate from 3 libraries served)
- (D). The existing vendors who are not in a position to supply more than 75% of the books ordered to them, will not be allowed to submit the tender in future.

9. TENDERS SECURITY /EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT

Tenderer shall furnish along with their tender, a tender security for Rs.50000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) valid for 150 days from the tender opening date in the form of crossed Demand draft in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, SJH, New Delhi/Bank Gurantee (proforma enclosed/fixed deposit receipt. Failure of the tenderer to furnish required earnest money deposit along with their tender will result into the rejection of their tender. The tender security is required to protect the purchaser against risk of tenderer's conduct which would warrant the security's forfeiture if:

- (A)A tenderer withdraws its tender or impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect during the period of tender validity as specified by the purchaser, or
- (B)In the case of a successful tenderer, if the tenderer fails to sign the contract, or fails to furnish performance security.

Unsuccessful tenderer's tender security will be discharged/returned as promptly as possible after the expiration of the period of tender validity prescribed by the purchaser but not later than 30 days of the award of rate contract. No interest is payable on the tender security amount.

10.DETAILS OF REQUIREMENTS:-

Supply of books, reports, serials and similar monographic publications (excluding periodicals and journals) published/issued by the publishers(as per list at Annexure-A) on order or on approval basis.

11.PRICE SCHEDULE AND PAYMENT TERMS:-

- (A) Tenderers should quote rate of discount(in percentage) offered in publishers' price in Annexure-A. Director, NML does not bind herself to accept the lowest bid (if it is unreasonable) or any tender and also reserves the right of rejecting all or any of the tender without assigning any reason.
- (B) The current bank exchange rate(TT selling rate) on the date of ordering shall be used for conversion of foreign currencies supported by a certificate issued
- (C) by a scheduled bank and countersigned by the supplier. All payments will be made in Indian rupees only through account payee cheque.

- (D) Net payable price will be the publishers price less discount offered.
- (E) Bill/invoice in triplicate in the name of Director, National Medical Library, pre-receipted (on revenue stamp, if necessary) quoting order number and date are to be sent to NML for payment. All payments(100% payment) will be released only after the entire supply has been received to the satisfaction of purchaser.
- (E) The bill/invoice should bear the certificate from the supplier that only latest edition(s)has been supplied and that the prices have been charged correctly and in accordance with the latest publishers catalogue/invoice or importer/distributors invoice. Copy of such invoice /catalogue by the supplier should be submitted along with the bill.

12.TERMS OF DELIVERY:-

Free delivery at National Medical Library, New Delhi.

13. DELIVERY PERIOD :-

- (A) Serial will be procured on standing order basis and therefore should be supplied as soon as published or become available in the market but not later than 15 days after their availability in the market.
- (B) Books received on approval basis will be finalized within 60 days of the receipt in NML.
- (C) All orders(except standing orders) placed by NML will be supplied within 30 days. For the books to be imported from foreign publishers, the supplies should be completed within 60 days of placing order. The supplier should inform in writing to the purchaser about all such books and their probable date of supply.

4. PERFORMANCE SECURITY (SECURITY DEPOSIT)

Within 15 days of placement of the supply order against the rate contract, supplier shall furnish performance security for an amount in rupees equivalent to 5%(five percent) of the value of the supply order in the form of a bank

guarantee (proforma enclosed) or fixed deposit receipt for 60 days after the delivery period of the supply order. The performance security will be

discharged/returned within 30 days of completion of the supply order. No interest is payable on the security deposit.

15. PENALTY CLAUSE:-

- (A) For delays-if the supplier fails to supply- books, reports, serials as ordered to them within the time period specified in the contract, the purchaser shall deduct from contract price a sum equivalent to 0.5 percent of the price of delayed items for each week of delay or part thereof until actual delivery up to a maximum of 10(ten percent). Once the maximum reached, the purchaser may consider termination of the contract.
- (B) Termination for default the purchaser may, without prejudice to any other remedy or breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, terminate the contract in whole or part if the supplier fails to deliver any or all publications ordered to him within the time period specified the contract, or if the supplier fails to performance other obligation(s) under the contract. In the event of the purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part, the purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate undelivered books, reports, serials and similar publications and similar publications and the supplier shall be liable to pay for any excess costs for such publications. However, the supplier shall continue performance of the contract to the extent not terminated.
- (C) Force majeure the supplier shall not be liable for (A) and (B) above, if its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of an event of force majeure(means an event beyond the control of the supplier and not involving the supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable). Such events may include, but are not restricted to, acts of the purchaser either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes. The supplier shall promptly notify the purchaser in writing of such conditions and the causes thereof.

16. AUTHORITY PLACING THE SUPPLY ORDERS:-

On award of rate contract on the basis of this tender, the supply orders as and when required during the currency of the rate contract period shall be placed by the Director, National Medical Library, New Delhi on the supplier.

 - (B) Tender security/earnest money deposit
 - (C)Latest ITCC/ITR and banker's report
 - (D)Certificate from 3 libraries served

19.LATE TENDERS:

Any tender received by the purchaser after deadline for submission of tender prescribed by the purchaser, will be rejected and/or returned unopened to the tenderer.

20. MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWL OF TENDERS:-

- (A) Provided at written notice of the modification or with drawl is received by the purchaser prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of tenders.
- (B)The tenderer's modification or with drawl notice shall be prepared sealed, marked and dispatched in accordance with the provisions of tender notice a with drawl notice may also be sent by telex or fax or cable but followed by a signed confirmation copy, post marked not later than the deadline for submission of tenders.
- (C) No tender may be modified subsequent to the deadline for submission of tenders.
- (D) No tender may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of tenders and the expiration of the period of tender validity. With drawl of a tender during the interval may result in the tenderer's forfeiture of its security.

23. RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding to the parties concerned.
