TELEPHONE AND DATA COMMUNICATION SUPPLIES

1.0 **<u>INTENT</u>**:

The intent of this bid is to establish a contract for Telecommunication related supplies for the Office of Enterprise Technology (OET). OET will be request pricing from all vendors on project estimated to be \$15,000 or more.

The County is aware that prices change rapidly in this industry, therefore vendors may submit updated published price lists annually during the contract period, however, all discounts offered will remain the same.

2.0 **SPECIFICATIONS**:

2.1 GUARANTEE:

All equipment, units and components shall be guaranteed in accordance with the following clauses:

The equipment offered is free from defects in design and construction and that it will give continuous and efficient service under normal conditions for a period of twelve (12) months from date of delivery.

The equipment is the manufacturer's standard design in construction and that no changes or substitutions have been made.

The awarded vendors shall, at no cost, promptly (within 72 hours from time of initial request) replace the product(s) purchased. This replacement shall apply to products purchase twelve (12) months from date of accepted delivery.

2.2 MANUFACTURER'S PRICE LIST:

Bidders shall submit four (4) copies of <u>their</u> each current <u>catalog listing each</u> manufacturer's price list offered with their bid and enter a percent discount offered from <u>list</u> on items from these manufacturers price lists. 2.3 REFERENCES:

Contractors must provide at least five (5) reference accounts to which they are presently providing this service. Included must be the name of the government or company, individual to contact, phone number, street address and e-mail address.

2.4 DELIVERY:

Delivery is required F.O.B. Destination, freight pre-paid within Five (5) days of receipt of Purchase Order or phone order, to any delivery location within Maricopa County as specified by the County. Contractor shall indicate on Pricing Documentation (Attachment A) any additional freight or handling charges that would be associated with special shipping and/or handling delivery.

2.5 SHIPPING:

Bid prices shall be made F.O.B. destination to the Using Agency within Maricopa County. The Contractor shall retain title and control of all goods until they are delivered and the contract coverage has been completed. All claims for visible or concealed damage shall be filed by the Contractor. The County will notify the Contractor of any damaged goods and shall assist the Contractor in arranging for inspection.

2.6 STOCK:

The Contractor shall be expected to stock locally sufficient quantities as may be necessary to meet the County's needs.

2.7 SHIPPING DOCUMENTS

A packing list or other suitable shipping document shall accompany each shipment and shall include the following:

- (1) Name and address of the Contractor;
- (2) Name and address of the County Agency;
- (3) County purchase order number;
- (4) A description of material shipped, including item number, quantity, number of containers and package number, if applicable.

2.8 ACCEPTANCE:

Once the Materials have been delivered, the Using Agency shall have a reasonable opportunity to inspect them. The Using Agency shall have ten (10) days to perform its acceptance testing and inspection of the Materials, after which time the Materials shall be deemed accepted unless the Using Agency rejects the Materials.

2.9 WARRANTY:

The minimum warranty period shall be twelve (12) months. Warranty repair and/or replacement will be performed at no additional charge to Maricopa County. All warranty periods shall begin upon acceptance by the Using Agency.

2.10 SAMPLES:

Contractors may be requested to furnish samples of items proposed for examination by the County. Any items so requested shall be furnished within five (5) working days from the date of request and furnished at <u>no cost</u> to the County and sent to the address designated in the Invitation for Bids.

2.11 ORDERING AUTHORITY

Contractors should understand that any request for purchase of materials or services shall be accompanied by a valid purchase order, issued by Office of Procurement Services, or by a CAPA (Certified Agency Procurement Aid). CAPA purchases are limited to values of less than \$2,500.00. No other request is valid.

2.12 CONTRACTOR REVIEW OF DOCUMENTS:

Contractor shall review its bid submission to assure the following requirements are met.

- 2.12.1 One (1) original and one (1) copy of all attachments is MANDATORY
- 2.12.2 Pricing pages (ATTACHMENT A) with CD, MANDATORY
- 2.12.3 Four (4) Copies of Catalogs/Price Lists (on CD), MANDATORY
- 2.12.4 Agreement page (ATTACHMENT B), MANDATORY
- 2.14.6 References (ATTACHMENT C), MANDATORY

2.13 USAGE REPORT:

The Contractor shall furnish the County <u>afterward</u> a <u>quarterly</u> usage report delineating the acquisition activity governed by the Contract. The format of the report shall be approved by the County and shall disclose the quantity and dollar value of each contract item by individual unit.

2.14 EXPEDITED DELIVERY:

- 2.14.1 If the Using Agency determines that rush shipping or other alternate shipping is required, it shall notify the Contractor. The Contractor shall determine any additional costs associated with such delivery terms and communicate that cost to the Using Agency.
- 2.14.2 The Using Agency shall not advise the Contractor to proceed with an expedited shipment until acceptable terms are agreed upon and a purchase order is issued. Upon agreeing to the additional costs, the Using Agency shall advise the Contractor to proceed.
- 2.14.3 Upon receipt of material(s) and invoicing, the Using Agency shall ensure that any additional charges are in compliance with and do not exceed agreed to costs. The Using Agency shall retain all documents related to these costs within the agency purchase file.

2.15 WAREHOUSE/DISTRIBUTION CENTER:

The Contractor shall have access to a local warehouse/distribution center(s) within Twenty-Five (25) Miles of the Phoenix, Arizona metropolitan area capable of providing the material(s) listed herein at the time of bid submission.

2.15.1 Material discontinuance applies only to those materials specifically listed on any resultant contract. This will not apply to catalog items not specifically listed on any resultant contract.

2.16 INVOICES AND PAYMENTS:

- 2.16.1 The Contractor shall submit two (2) legible copies of their detailed invoice before payment(s) can be made. At a minimum, the invoice must provide the following information:

 - 2.16.1.2 County bill-to name and contact information
 - 2.16.1.3 Contract Serial Number
 - 2.16.1.4 County purchase order number
 - 2.16.1.5 Invoice number and date

 - 2.16.1.10 Description of Purchase (product or services)
 - 2.16.1.11 Pricing per unit of purchase
 - 2.16.1.12 Extended price
 - 2.16.1.13 Total Amount Due

Problems regarding billing or invoicing shall be directed to the using agency as listed on the Purchase Order.

- 2.16.2 Payment will be made to the Contractor by Accounts Payable through the Maricopa County Vendor Express Payment Program. This is an Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) process. After Award the Contractor shall fill out an EFT Enrollment form (to be provided by the Procurement Officer) or as located on the County Department of Finance Website as a fillable PDF document (www.maricopa.gov/finance/).
- 2.16.3 EFT payments to the routing and account numbers designated by the Contractor will include the details on the specific invoices that the payment covers. The Contractor is required to discuss remittance delivery capabilities with their designated financial institution for access to those details.
- 2.17 TAX:

Tax shall not be levied against labor. Sales/use tax will be determined by County. Tax will not be used in determining low price.

3.0 **SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

3.1 CONTRACT TERM:

This Invitation for Bid is for awarding a firm, fixed-price purchasing contract to cover a Three (3) year period.

3.2 OPTION TO EXTEND:

The County may, at their option and with the approval of the Contractor, extend the period of this Contract up to a maximum of Three (3), one (1) year options, (or at the County's sole discretion, extend the contract on a month to month basis for a maximum of six (6) months after expiration). The Contractor shall be notified in writing by the Office of Procurement Services of the County's intention to extend the contract period at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the expiration of the original contract period.

3.3 PRICE ADJUSTMENTS:

Any requests for reasonable price adjustments (Catalog Updates) must be submitted sixty (60) days prior to the annual contract anniversary date etc. Requests for adjustment in cost of labor and/or materials must be supported by appropriate documentation. If County agrees to the adjusted price terms, County shall issue written approval of the change. The reasonableness of the request will be determined by comparing the request with the Consumer Price Index or by performing a market survey.

3.4 INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE:

3.4.1 INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless County, its agents, representatives, officers, directors, officials, and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including, but not limited to, attorney fees, court costs, expert witness fees, and the cost of appellate proceedings, relating to, arising out of, or alleged to have resulted from the negligent acts, errors, omissions or mistakes relating to the performance of this Contract. Contractor's duty to defend, indemnify and hold harmless County, its agents, representatives, officers, directors, officials, and employees shall arise in connection with any claim, damage, loss or expense that is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease, death, or injury to, impairment, or destruction of property, including loss of use resulting there from, caused by any negligent acts, errors, omissions or mistakes in the performance of this Contract including any person for whose acts, errors, omissions or mistakes Contractor may be legally liable.

The amount and type of insurance coverage requirements set forth herein will in no way be construed as limiting the scope of the indemnity in this paragraph.

The scope of this indemnification does not extend to the sole negligence of County.

3.5 INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Contractor, at Contractor's own expense, shall purchase and maintain the herein stipulated minimum insurance from a company or companies duly licensed by the State of Arizona and possessing a current A.M. Best, Inc. rating of B^{++6} . In lieu of State of Arizona licensing, the stipulated insurance may be purchased from a company or companies, which are authorized to do business in the State of Arizona, provided that said insurance companies meet the approval of County. The form of any insurance policies and forms must be acceptable to County.

All insurance required herein shall be maintained in full force and effect until all work or service required to be performed under the terms of the Contract is satisfactorily completed and formally accepted. Failure to do so may, at the sole discretion of County, constitute a material breach of this Contract.

Contractor's insurance shall be primary insurance as respects County, and any insurance or selfinsurance maintained by County shall not contribute to it. Any failure to comply with the claim reporting provisions of the insurance policies or any breach of an insurance policy warranty shall not affect the County's right to coverage afforded under the insurance policies.

The insurance policies may provide coverage that contains deductibles or self-insured retentions. Such deductible and/or self-insured retentions shall not be applicable with respect to the coverage provided to County under such policies. Contractor shall be solely responsible for the deductible and/or self-insured retention and County, at its option, may require Contractor to secure payment of such deductibles or self-insured retentions by a surety bond or an irrevocable and unconditional letter of credit.

County reserves the right to request and to receive, within 10 working days, certified copies of any or all of the herein required insurance policies and/or endorsements. County shall not be obligated, however, to review such policies and/or endorsements or to advise Contractor of any deficiencies in such policies and endorsements, and such receipt shall not relieve Contractor from, or be deemed a waiver of County's right to insist on strict fulfillment of Contractor's obligations under this Contract.

The insurance policies required by this Contract, except Workers' Compensation, and Errors and Omissions, shall name County, its agents, representatives, officers, directors, officials and employees as Additional Insureds.

The policies required hereunder, except Workers' Compensation, and Errors and Omissions, shall contain a waiver of transfer of rights of recovery (subrogation) against County, its agents, representatives, officers, directors, officials and employees for any claims arising out of Contractor's work or service.

Contractor is required to procure and maintain the following coverages indicated by a checkmark:

3.5.1 Commercial General Liability:

Commercial General Liability insurance and, if necessary, Commercial Umbrella insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence, \$2,000,000 Products/Completed Operations Aggregate, and \$2,000,000 General Aggregate Limit. The policy shall include coverage for bodily injury, broad form property damage, personal injury, products and completed operations and blanket contractual coverage, and shall not contain any provision which would serve to limit third party action over claims. There shall be no endorsement or modification of the CGL limiting the scope of coverage for liability arising from explosion, collapse, or underground property damage.

3.5.2 Automobile Liability:

Commercial/Business Automobile Liability insurance and, if necessary, Commercial Umbrella insurance with a combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence with respect to any of the Contractor's owned, hired, and non-owned vehicles assigned to or used in performance of the Contractor's work or services under this Contract.

3.5.3 Workers' Compensation:

Workers' Compensation insurance to cover obligations imposed by federal and state statutes having jurisdiction of Contractor's employees engaged in the performance of the work or services under this Contract; and Employer's Liability insurance of not less than \$100,000 for each accident, \$100,000 disease for each employee, and \$500,000 disease policy limit.

Contractor waives all rights against County and its agents, officers, directors and employees for recovery of damages to the extent these damages are covered by the Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability or commercial umbrella liability insurance obtained by Contractor pursuant to this Contract.

- 3.5.4 Certificates of Insurance.
 - 3.5.4.1 Prior to commencing work or services under this Contract, Contractor shall have insurance in effect as required by the Contract in the form provided by the County, issued by Contractor's insurer(s), as evidence that policies providing the required coverage, conditions and limits required by this Contract are in full force and effect. Such certificates shall be made available to the County upon 48 hours notice. BY SIGNING THE AGREEMENT PAGE THE CONTRACTOR AGREES TO THIS REQUIREMENT AND FAILURE TO MEET THIS REQUIREMENT WILL RESULT IN CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT.

In the event any insurance policy (ies) required by this contract is (are) written on a "claims made" basis, coverage shall extend for two years past completion and acceptance of Contractor's work or services and as evidenced by annual Certificates of Insurance.

If a policy does expire during the life of the Contract, a renewal certificate must be sent to County fifteen (15) days prior to the expiration date.

3.5.4.2 Cancellation and Expiration Notice.

Insurance required herein shall not be permitted to expire, be canceled, or materially changed without thirty (30) days prior written notice to the County.

3.6 PROCUREMENT CARD ORDERING CAPABILITY:

It is the intent of Maricopa County to utilize a procurement card that may be used by the County from time to time, to place and make payment for orders under the Contract. Contractors without this capability may be considered non-responsive and not eligible for award consideration.

3.7 INTERNET ORDERING CAPABILITY:

It is the intent of the County to utilize the Internet to place orders under this Contract. Contractors without this capability may be considered non-responsive and not eligible for award consideration.

3.8 NO GUARANTEED QUANTITIES:

The Contractor understands and hereby acknowledges that the County makes no representations nor guarantees the Contractor any minimum or maximum number of units of product(s) to be provided under this Contract

3.9 ORDERING AUTHORITY:

- 3.9.1 The Contractor should understand that any request for purchase of product(s) shall be accompanied by a valid purchase order, issued by Office of Procurement Services, or by a Certified Agency Procurement Aid (CAPA).
- 3.9.2 County departments, cities, other counties, schools and special districts, universities, nonprofit educational and public health institutions may also purchase from under this Contract at their discretion and/or other state and local agencies (Customers) may procure the products under this Contract by the issuance of a purchase order to the Respondent. Purchase orders must cite the Contract number.
- 3.9.3 Contract award is in accordance with the Maricopa County Procurement Code. All requirements for the competitive award of this Contract have been met. A purchase order

for the product(s) is the only document necessary for Customers to purchase and for the Contractor to proceed with delivery of product(s) available under this Contract.

3.9.4 Any attempt to represent any product not specifically awarded under this Contract is a violation of the Contract. Any such action is subject to the legal and contractual remedies available to the County, inclusive of, but not limited to, Contract cancellation, suspension and/or debarment of the Contractor.

All costs necessary to verify compliance are the responsibility of the Contractor.

3.20 INFLUENCE

As prescribed in MC1-1202 of the Maricopa County Procurement Code, any effort to influence an employee or agent to breach the Maricopa County Ethical Code of Conduct or any ethical conduct, may be grounds for Disbarment or Suspension under MC1-902. An attempt to influence includes, but is not limited to:

- **3.20.1** A Person offering or providing a gratuity, gift, tip, present, donation, money, entertainment or educational passes or tickets, or any type valuable contribution or subsidy,
- **3.20.2** That is offered or given with the intent to influence a decision, obtain a contract, garner favorable treatment, or gain favorable consideration of any kind.

If a Person attempts to influence any employee or agent of Maricopa County, the Chief Procurement Officer, or his designee, reserves the right to seek any remedy provided by the Maricopa County Procurement Code, any remedy in equity or in the law, or any remedy provided by this contract.

3.21 POST AWARD MEETING:

The Contractor shall be required to attend a post-award meeting with the Using Agency to discuss the terms and conditions of this Contract. This meeting will be coordinated by the Procurement Officer of the Contract.
