Sample Letter of Agreement for Offsite Supervision

This is not a form. This suggested information should appear on the letterhead of the employer and should be signed and dated prior to gaining hours of experience.

This document is referred to as "the letter of agreement for offsite supervision." This is frankly a misstatement as this letter is to exist when the supervisor is not paid by the intern's/trainee's employer for the provision of supervision, (i.e., the supervisor volunteers to provide the supervision or the supervisor is paid by the supervisee). Typically, this situation occurs when there is no qualified supervisor "on site," thus, the commonly used phrase, "offsite supervision." Such an agreement is permitted in all work settings *except* private practice.

The intern/trainee shall maintain an original of this letter of agreement for each work setting where the letter is necessary and shall submit this letter with the application for the license/exam.
