# Arkansas Humanities Council Friends of Mosaic Templars Cultural Center Excursion Grant Application Guidelines

#### Who May Apply

The Arkansas Humanities Council invites grant applications from kindergarten through twelfth grade public, private, or parochial schools within Arkansas.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

To apply for a Friends of Mosaic Templars Cultural Center Excursion grant, the applicant organization must meet the requirements set forth by the Arkansas Humanities Council:

- All group visits (grades K-12) must be scheduled in advance by calling the MTCC Education Department. This will ensure that your students receive the best possible tour or program. Once scheduled, pre- and post-visit materials will be provided along with written confirmation of your visit. For more information, please go to the MTCC website: www.mosaictemplarscenter.com.
- Review tours and programs offered by the Mosaic Templars Cultural Center before calling. Have a first- and second-choice date and program just in case. Applicants are encouraged to review information on grant deadlines and the application process found in the guidelines below.
- Once you have spoken with a member of the Education Department staff and selected a date, time, and tour/program, you will receive a Confirmation Sheet via email or postal mail from Mosaic Templars Cultural Center. Please submit a copy of the confirmation form along with the application.
- Arrange to have (1) adult chaperone per (10) students (grades 4-12) or (1) adult chaperone per (8) students (grades K-3).
- For an application to be considered, the school principal must approve and sign the cover sheet accompanying the grant application.
- > The grant period must not exceed one year.
- > The grant request must not exceed the \$1,000 limit. A detailed budget is required.

### **Eligible Activities**

Friends of Mosaic Templars Cultural Center Excursion Grant may be used for the following.

- Books pertaining to African American history and culture (individual and classroom sets)
- > Field trips (bus driver fees, fees for the use of the bus, and entrance fees.)
- Substitute teachers (licensed or non-licensed)

## **Deadline for Submission**

Applications for Friends of Mosaic Templars Cultural Center Excursion grant must be postmarked by the first of each month except December, when no grants are awarded.

# **Grant Period**

The following timeline for processing grant applications and implementing projects is stated below.

- > Deadline for submission: First day of each month
- > Grants awarded: During the last week of each month, except December.
- ➢ Funds availability: On or around the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the month in which application is received and awarded.
- Grant evaluation report deadline: Final reports are due 90 days following the end date of the grant period.
