Building commissioning is the systematic process of evaluating buildings to make sure that the building systems are designed, built, and operated as intended. Expanded building commissioning has the potential to improve public and .private commercial buildings in California in terms of their energy efficiency, comfort and indoor air quality. Collaborative members are working to address the barriers to commissioning, including lack of awareness, owner perception that they already receive commissioned buildings, and the lack of a commissioning provider infrastructure in California.

Mr. Tav Commins who is the contract manager of this membership is a Commission employee and a nonsalaried member of the CCC serving on its Advisory Council.
