CRITERIA

Applicant whose parents, grandparents or legal guardian graduated from the former Mohegan Community College or Thames Valley State Technical College or the current Three Rivers Community College. Recipient is selected by the TR Alumni Board of Directors.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for a scholarship, you have to complete at least one semester at Three Rivers and be enrolled in at least 3 credit hours during the spring 2011 semester. Students are encouraged to apply for more than one scholarship if they meet the criteria. Only credits earned through traditional courses completed at TRCC are considered for eligibility. Applicants cannot factor in transfer credit, CLEP, DSST, or credits earned through the portfolio development assessment as courses completed. Employees (except student workers or work-study students) of the college are ineligible to apply.

THE ESSAY: Write an essay about why you deserve to receive a scholarship. Indicate how you meet the stated criteria and your objectives. You may want to include your educational, career or personal goals. Demonstrate your talent by writing about any special interests or special circumstances that you may wish the selection committee to consider. If you are applying for a scholarship that requires a demonstrated financial need, employment, family responsibilities, evidence of leadership, community service or other requirements, please address that specifically in your essay.

ESSAY FORMAT: Use $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" white paper, type or use a computer. Limit the essay to no more than two pages. Use your name and essay as the title. Double space the body of your essay and use 1" margin all around.

SUPPORT MATERIAL:

- a. Be sure to attach three letters of recommendation. One letter from a Three Rivers faculty/staff member is requested.
- b. Include a student copy of your Three Rivers' academic history.
- c. Attach the name, address, degree and year graduated of the parent/grandparent who is an alumni, and which of the three colleges the parent graduated from.

Return your completed application either in person to the TRCC Scholarship Committee: c/o Dean of Student Services Office located in C245 or mail it with a postmark no later than Thursday, April 14, 2011 to TRCC Scholarship Committee, c/o Dean of Student Services Office, 574 New London Turnpike, Norwich, CT 06360.
