

## LOCKOUT-TAGOUT POLICY/TRAINING

Acknowledgement Form

On the date shown below, I have received training on the Machine Lockout Policy and Procedures. In brief, I was informed of the following:

The purpose of the policy is to prevent accidents. It is my responsibility to follow lockout procedures.

ALL machines are to be de-energized (ie. elimination of energy associated with electrical, air, gravitational, hydraulic, etc.) for the following:

1. Set-ups

- 2. Maintenance, servicing or repair
- 3. To remove jammed material

Machines with electric power cords can be locked out by removing the electrical plug from the wall power outlet.

## Lockout sequence is as follows:

- 1. Notify affected personnel.
- 2. Turn off power switch on machine.
- 3. Turn off power at power control box.
- 4. Lock the box "off" with my padlock.
- 5. Perform work needed on the machine.
- 6. Recheck to make sure all switches are off.
- 7. Remove padlock and return power to machine.

Equipment utilizing pneumatic sources as energy will be disconnected from air compressor resource prior to any maintenance, set up or adjustments.

There is a discipline section to this policy. I will be subject to 3 days off without pay for a serious violation of this safety rule if I do not follow this procedure.

I understand the Company Lockout-Tagout Policy and agree to follow the rules and procedures of the Policy.
