Dear Sir/Ms:
Make the follow changes to the Bid Documents:
In the Bid Book (pages 8 and 12), REMOVE the first pages of the "CONTRACT AGREEMENT, OFFER \& AWARD" and REPLACE them with the attached new first pages reflecting the new completion date.

In the Bid Book (page 27), REMOVE "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 105, General Scope of Work, (Environmental Requirements)" 1 page dated 4/7/09 and REPLACE with the attached new "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 105, General Scope of Work, (Environmental Requirements)" 1 page dated 6/2/09.

In the Bid Book, after page 30, ADD the attached "SPECIAL PROVISION, SECTION 107, TIME, (Limitations of Operations and Supplemental Liquidated Damages)" 1 page dated June 30, 2009.

In the Bid Book (page 137), REMOVE the "Environmental Summary Sheet" and REPLACE with the attached updated "Environmental Summary Sheet" reflecting new instream work dates.

The following questions have been received:
Question: We are requesting the following, Copy of existing bridge plans, Hydrologic report, and geotechnical report. We also request a plan showing right of way and the location of the new bridge in relation to the existing bridge and highway.

Response: Existing Bridge Plans, Hydrologic Report, and Geotechnical Report are located on the project web page. For right of way and existing locations, please see the project plans for 9184.60 (also downloadable from the 9184.60 project web page) for right of way information.

Question: There does not seem to be any project completion or milestone dates listed in the Special Provisions?


Response: See New Special Provision 107

Question: Page 30 of the Special Provisions seems to not apply to this contract, it appears to be written for the dirt contract.

Response: This special provision shall be removed from this contract.

Question: Per Special Provision, access to the work area will not be provided until 11/15/09. That means that the Bridge Contractor will not be able to start work on the pier until the 2010 in water work date of $7 / 1 / 2010$. The Bridge Contractor will not be able to start demo of the existing bridge until after the new deck is paved in about may of 2011. The pier removal cannot be done until the in water date of $7 / 1 / 2011$. I also believe the earthwork contract calls for a completion date of $11 / 18 / 2010$ which doesn't allow for pavement or existing bridge demo in 2011.

Response: The contract completion date and in water work date has been changed. The Department stands behind that the new bridge can be complete and ready for pavement with these changes by September 15 th, 2010. The new completion date of November $15^{\text {th }}, 2011$ will allow the contractor to demo the old bridge in the next season.

Question: Will the Highway contractor for PIN 9184.60 be responsible for clearing? If so, when will this be completed?

Response: The clearing is the responsibility of the Highway contractor, as well as to provide access to the bridge site by November $15^{\text {th }}, 2009$.

Question: The Approach Slab and Grade Beams reinforcing steel bar schedule does not match the plan sheet 21. The Approach slab schedule lists bar mark AS1900 but the plan show AS2900. The grade beam schedule lists bar mark G1950 but the plan shows G1650. Which is correct?

Response: AS2900 and G1650

Question: Drawing 17, Superstructure note \#7 states the reinforcing steel for the concrete slab is incidental to the 502 pay item. The weight of the bar schedule, including the " S " deck bars is very close to B.I \#503.12 listed weight. Which bid item should the deck bars fall under.

Response: 502.26

Consider these changes and information prior to submitting your bid on July 15, 2009.

## CONTRACT AGREEMENT, OFFER \& AWARD

AGREEMENT made on the date last signed below, by and between the State of Maine, acting through and by its Department of Transportation (Department), an agency of state government with its principal administrative offices located at Child Street, Augusta, Maine, with a mailing address at 16 State House Station, Augusta, Maine 04333-0016, and
a corporation or other legal entity organized under the laws of the State of $\qquad$ , with its principal place of business located at $\qquad$

The Department and the Contractor, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this Agreement (the "Contract"), hereby agree as follows:

## A. The Work.

The Contractor agrees to complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract including Extra Work in conformity with the Contract, PIN 015619.00, for the Wild River Bridge Replacement in the town of Gilead, County of Oxford, Maine. The Work includes construction, maintenance during construction, warranty as provided in the Contract, and other incidental work.

The Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing all supervision, labor, equipment, tools supplies, permanent materials and temporary materials required to perform the Work including construction quality control including inspection, testing and documentation, all required documentation at the conclusion of the project, warranting its work and performing all other work indicated in the Contract.

The Department shall have the right to alter the nature and extent of the Work as provided in the Contract; payment to be made as provided in the same.

## B. Time.

The Contractor agrees to complete all Work, except warranty work, on or before November 15, 2011. Further, the Department may deduct from moneys otherwise due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as Liquidated Damages in accordance with Sections 107.7 and 107.8 of the State of Maine Department of Transportation Standard Specifications, Revision of December 2002 and related Special Provisions.

SPECIAL PROVISION<br>SECTION 105<br>General Scope of Work<br>(Environmental Requirements)

In-Water work consists of any activity conducted below the normal high water mark of a river, steam, brook, lake, pond or "Coastal Wetland" areas that are subject to tidal action during the highest tide level for the year which an activity is proposed as identified in the tide tables published by the National Ocean Service. http://www.oceanservice.noaa.gov/ For the full definition of "Coastal Wetlands", please refer to 38 MRSA 480-B(2)
I. In-Water Work shall not be allowed between the dates of $10 / 1$ and $6 / 14$.
(In-Water work is allowed from 6/15 to 9/30.)
II. In-Water work window applies to the following water bodies at the following station \#'s:

1. Wild River $3+420$ to $3+480$
III. Special Conditions:

IV. Approvals:

1. Temporary Soil Erosion and Water Pollution Control Plan
V. All activities are prohibited (including placement and removal of cofferdams unless otherwise permitted by Regulatory Agencies) below the normal high water mark if outside the prescribed in-water work window, except for the following:
2. Work within a cofferdam constructed according to MaineDOT's Standard Specifications and in adherence with the contractors approved "Soil Erosion and Water Pollution Control Plan".
VI. No work is allowed that completely blocks a river, stream, or brook without providing downstream flow.

NOTE: Regulatory Review and Approval is required to modify the existing In-Water work window.

## SPECIAL PROVISION <br> SECTION 107 <br> TIME

(Limitations of Operations and Supplemental Liquidated Damages)
All bridge work shall be complete and the site ready for pavement and the bridge ready for membrane and pavement by September 15, 2010 to allow the Highway Contractor to complete his work. The Contractor will be assessed Supplemental Liquidated Damages at the rate of one thousand dollars (\$1000) per day for each calendar day beyond September 15, 2010 that this requirement is not met.

Assessment of Supplemental Liquidated Damages will be in addition to liquidated damages specified in Section 107 of the Standard Specifications.

The contract completion date of this contract shall be November $15^{\text {th }}, 2011$.
