Speakers

Bryan E. Bledsoe, DO, FACEP, FAAEM, EMT-P

Dr. Bledsoe is an emergency physician, researcher and EMS author. Presently he is Professor of Emergency Medicine and Director of the EMS Fellowship program at the University of Nevada School of Medicine and an attending Emergency Physician at the University Medical Center of Southern Nevada in Las Vegas. Prior to medical school, Dr. Bledsoe worked as an EMT, a paramedic and a paramedic instructor. He is very active in emergency medicine and EMS research, is the author of numerous EMS textbooks and has in excess of 1 million books in print.

Joseph J. Mistovich, M.Ed., NREMT-P

Mr. Mistovich is the chairperson of the Department of Health Professions and a Professor at Youngstown State University in Youngstown, Ohio. He has more than 27 years of experience as an educator in EMS. He has authored numerous EMS textbooks and EMS journal articles. He is a frequent speaker at state and national EMS clinical and education conferences. He is a member of the Board of Directors for the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the EMS Professions (CoAEMSP) which is the national accrediting committee for EMS programs.

Dr. Bennett is an Associate Montana State Medical Examiner and Pathologist for Forensic Medicine and Pathology, PLLC in Billings where he practices. He is a Consulting Pathologist for Billings Clinic and St. Vincents Healthcare in Billings. He has published several journal entries for cases in pathology and forensic science. Dr. Bennett is an Adjunct Professor of Science at Rocky Mountain College in Billings and has been a presenter for numerous training programs for physicians, nurses, pre hospital providers and law enforcement personnel across the country and overseas. He has performed over 10,000 forensic autopsies, and testified in hundreds of trials in Criminal and Civil Courts across the US and overseas.
