Dear NRC Licensee:

By now you should have been contacted by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regarding how they will handle the transfer of regulatory authority for your licensed activities as the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (PA) became an NRC Agreement State, effective March 31, 2008. Please be advised that the PA Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Radiation Protection, will implement that new authority. This correspondence will alert you to the changes and activities that will be forthcoming during this transition.

The attached PA Information Notice 2008-01 provides an overview of the most significant areas affecting your radioactive materials program. These include changes in reporting procedures, applicable regulations, licensing and inspection, the issuance of new license documents, and the billing of fees. For some licensees who have made a commitment to the NRC to provide Increased Controls (IC) for the security of radioactive material, PA will require, by order, that they be continued. Some licensees have provided formal Financial Assurance (FA) to the NRC to ensure that their licensed facilities can be decommissioned. PA will require that FA be transferred to PA or be replaced with an equivalent financial instrument.
