To be eligible for licensure by reciprocity you must be a nonresident of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and hold a current license by the state of your domicile from a reciprocal state. Contact Licensing Board where currently hold a license request that State vou and CERTIFICATION/VERIFICATION OF LICENSE be sent DIRECTLY to the Pennsylvania State Board of Auctioneer Examiners. Certification/Verification of License is required from all states in which you have ever held/hold a license. Copies of licenses or certifications from applicants will NOT be accepted.

REQUIRED BOND INFORMATION:

- The bonding company MUST be licensed by the Pennsylvania Insurance Department to operate in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Bond must be in the amount of \$5,000 payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Bond must indicate that it is for an "Auctioneer."
- The bond form must be signed and witnessed.
- The bonding company MUST sign the bond and imprint their seal in the appropriate
- A certified copy of the Power of Attorney MUST be attached to the bond.
- Bond submitted MUST be the original document with original signatures.

The Consent of Nonresident Licensee MUST be completed and notarized.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: ALL ITEMS LISTED MUST BE COMPLETED IN ORDER TO PROCESS THE APPLICATION. IF THE APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETED IN ITS ENTIRETY OR THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ARE NOT PROVIDED, PROCESSING TIME WILL BE DELAYED.

AN APPLICATION WILL BE DEEMED WITHDRAWN IF THE BOARD HAS REQUESTED ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FROM YOU, THE APPLICANT, AND YOU HAVE NOT RESPONDED TO THE REQUEST <u>WITHIN 45 DAYS</u> OF THE LETTER. ONCE AN APPLICATION IS CONSIDERED WITHDRAWN, REGARDLESS OF THE REASON, A NEW APPLICATION AND FEE WILL BE REQUIRED.

Reciprocity Agreement: (1) The auctioneer licensing laws of the nonresident state must extend to licensed auctioneer and apprentice auctioneers of this Commonwealth the same rights and privileges and the same authority to conduct auction sales in that state as this act extends to nonresidents of this Commonwealth with the necessity of the licensed auctioneers and apprentice auctioneers of this Commonwealth to obtain additional or further licenses or authority from any political subdivision of that state to conduct an auction sale. (2) The nonresident auctioneer or apprentice auctioneer is only permitted to sell at auction in this Commonwealth whatever property the laws of his state permit nonresident auctioneers and apprentice auctioneers to sell at auction.

NON-RESIDENT LICENSEES are ineligible to sponsor apprentices. A non-resident auctioneer is not a qualified auctioneer for the purposes of sponsoring or employing an apprentice auctioneer.
