MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Applicant must be the daughter, son or under legal guardianship of an elected or appointed official or an employee of a Public Agency that is a participant of the Nebraska Public Agency Investment Trust.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or incoming college freshman in good standing at the institution of higher education.
- 3. Applicant must complete an essay (Section D).
 - a. Essay needs to be two hundred-fifty to five hundred words on any subject matter relating to local, state or national government.
 - b. Essay must be original work.
 - c. Essay needs to include a title.
 - d. Essay may be submitted in type written form or on a 3.5" disk labeled with your full name. Please no Macintosh formats.
- 4. Applicant must attend a post-secondary institution within Nebraska during the next academic year.
- 5. Applicant must type and complete Sections A and C of the application.
- 6. Affirmation of class rank and test score by the high school guidance counselor (Section B).
