How to Complete Statutory Declaration for Sea Service

Self Declared Sea Service Will Not Be Accepted

Commercial Sea Service:..... can only be declared by a person (to the satisfaction of the Department) with direct knowledge of the service claimed (usually declared by the Owner or Master of the vessel).

Recreational Sea Service:..... can be declared by a person with prior knowledge of the completed sea service.

Step 1. (1), (2) & (3) To be completed by the person making the Statutory Declaration (Declarant) as to the applicant's (the person applying for sea service assessment) sea service.

Step 2. (4) Enter the applicant's name and date of birth.

Example:

sincerely declare that the sea time of John Citizen (name), whose date of birth is 24 May 1970 (date of birth), set out below is a true and correct record.
