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# How to Complete Statutory Declaration for Sea Service

#### Self Declared Sea Service Will Not Be Accepted

Commercial Sea Service:	can only be declared by a person (to the satisfaction of the Department) with
direct knowledge of the service claimed	(usually declared by the Owner or Master of the vessel).

**Recreational Sea Service:** can be declared by a person with prior knowledge of the completed sea service.

- **Step 1.** (1), (2) & (3) To be completed by the person making the Statutory Declaration (*Declarant*) as to the applicant's (*the person applying for sea service assessment*) sea service.
- **Step 2.** (4) Enter the applicant's name and date of birth.

#### **Example:**

sincerely declare that the sea time of <u>John Citizen</u> (name), whose date of birth is <u>24 May 1970</u> (date of birth), set out below is a true and correct record.

**Step 3.** Complete the sea time table:
