All documents must be originals, or copies certified by a Justice of the Peace, appropriate certifying authority or an authorised UWA staff member. If documents are in a language other than English, the original document must be accompanied by an official English translation.

NOTE: Additional documents other than those requested within this application will be removed from your application and disregarded in the faculty selection process. These include Curricula Vitae, references and personal statements.

All applications received without supporting documentation will experience delays in processing.

PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP / PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS

All applicants must attach proof of Australian or New Zealand Citizenship or Australian Permanent Resident (PR) status. Acceptable documents (which must <u>also</u> be brought to the enrolment session if successful in being made an offer), include: original or certified copy of an Australian or New Zealand Birth Certificate; Passport (including relevant visa pages if you are an Australian PR).
