When you are in doubt of the spelling of a word, there are a couple of things to do. Set Word up to automatically check spelling (and grammar) as you type. Go to **TOOLS**, then select **OPTIONS**, then select the tab **SPELLING & GRAMMER.** 

Make sure the boxes are checked as shown below. You will notice a red squiggly line under words the dictionary questions. If you have a possible grammatical mistake, it will have a blue squiggly line underneath the questionable section.

At bottom of hill bear left around the bend / at stop sign bear to right / continue on 7<sup>th</sup> Street / at the 9<sup>th</sup> light turn left onto Market Street / go to 5<sup>th</sup> and Market Streets (2<sup>nd</sup> light on Market) / turn right on to 5<sup>th</sup> Street next light turn right / park in the parking garage.

light at 7<sup>th</sup> and Fairview Ave. (Kroger on right) next light 7<sup>th</sup> and Park Street (CVS and Wendy's on right) next light 7<sup>th</sup> and Liberty Street (Super America on left) next light 7<sup>th</sup> and Staunton Avenue next light 7<sup>th</sup> and East Street (Cottman's Transmission) next light 7<sup>th</sup> and Lynn Street (Sugars on right) stay in right lane
