- ❖ Pre-requisite courses: C30.0011 Economics of Global Business (Stern students) OR V31.0238 International Economics (CAS students)
 - ❖ Pre-reqs may be taken in the Fall 2009 semester
- ❖ Attendance at Info Session is strongly encouraged
- ❖ Minimum grade point average of 3.0
- ❖ Strong interest in travel abroad, particularly in a developing country
- ❖ Students studying abroad during Fall 2009 are eligible to participate, however students must be at Stern for the Spring 2010 semester.
