What is a Curriculum Plan?

Consider all of the requirements for your degree – including CORE, MAJOR, MINOR, and/or CERTIFICATE requirements. Be aware of prerequisites and consider requirements for Honors Program, if applicable. If you are currently undecided on your major, you should complete your Curriculum Plan for a major you are considering. Please note that this is a planning exercise. This curriculum plan may or may not reflect your actual class schedule next academic year.
